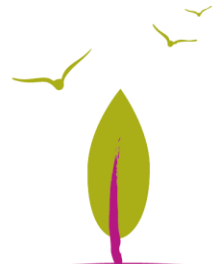

Giving Effectively to the Church

Becoming a regular giver to a local church is not only very rewarding but also helps us grow as followers of Jesus. There are a number of easy ways to give to the church:

1) **Online giving** (*for many this is the easiest option*). Regular gifts can be set up via the giving page on the church website (www.riversidevineyard.com). If you're a UK tax payer, please do make a Gift Aid declaration.

2) **Standing Order**. This is an instruction to your bank to make regular payments to the church. Please use the form opposite and return to the church office. Please Gift Aid if you can!

3) **Giving at Sunday services**. For some, especially those with irregular incomes, giving by cash or cheque (payable to Riverside Vineyard Christian Fellowship) at a Sunday service may be easiest. If you are a UK taxpayer, please do use a giving envelope so we can reclaim the tax you've already paid!

Giving tax efficiently

As a charity, the church is able to reclaim tax already paid by many givers. If you're a UK tax payer, please complete a Gift Aid declaration (overleaf). It costs you nothing and enables the church to reclaim the tax, simply meaning we can do more!

Gift Aid Declaration for Riverside Vineyard Christian Fellowship

Boost your donation by 25p of Gift Aid for every £1 you donate

Gift Aid is reclaimed by Riverside Vineyard Christian Fellowship from the tax you pay for the current tax year. Your address is needed to identify you as a current UK

In order to Gift Aid your donation you must tick one of the boxes below:
