
In the United States, the symbolic red poppy flower is worn on Memorial Day to commemorate the sacrifice of so many men and women who have given their lives fighting for their country.


For those who do not feel comfortable participating in person, please feel free to create a poppy and share them on social media using the hashtag #WeRemember .

We hope your family enjoys the Memorial Day holiday while remembering those who have sacrificed for us. 


HOW IT WORKS:



1. Complete the sentence with a name you wish to honor or a few words.




2. Color in the red poppy and try to fill in as much white space as possible.




