

Lake Forest Ranch/ Mission Camp Macon Hope Scholarship Application

The scholarship committee for the Lake Forest Ranch/Camp Macon Hope Scholarship program will award up to a \$2500 scholarship for the 2017/2018 school year. This scholarship will be presented to a high school senior residing in Noxubee County who will be graduating in May of 2017. The scholarship carries with it the potential for up to a total of \$10,000 (up to \$2500 annually to those who continue to qualify) during the pursuit of a four-year undergraduate degree. Deadline for submitting an application for this scholarship is **Friday April 7, 2017. All mailed applications must be postmarked by this deadline.** The recipient will be announced on Friday April 21st. Graduating seniors who have been actively involved in Camp Macon and who are actively involved in a local church in Noxubee County are encouraged to apply. Criteria

1. Noxubee County Resident for the past two (2) years.
2. Mission Camp Macon participant within the past two (2) years.
3. Entering freshman in any accredited college or university as a full time student for the 2017 fall session.
4. Grade Point Average of a “C” equivalent or above. For example a 2.0 on a 4.0 scale.
5. Must complete an application package which includes:
 - A completed typed application
 - Official high school transcript covering grades ninth (9th) through eleventh (11th), including your twelfth (12th) grade first semester averages
 - Two letters of recommendation from a teacher, minister, community leader, etc. None of which may be related to the applicant. One letter must be from the applicant’s Pastor or designated church leader.
6. Must enter college no later than the fall term of the academic year immediately following his/her graduation from high school.

Winner(s) will be notified and asked for the following:

- Attend Mission Camp Macon Family Night, Saturday July 15, 2017
- Submit a picture suitable for publishing in the local print media
- Submit proof of registration to their college of choice prior to receiving the funds
- All funds will be administered directly to the college/university
