Elementary Summer Program



Montessori School of Franklin is pleased to offer an eight-week summer program for elementary students, Kindergarten - Sixth Grade. This program gives students an opportunity to work on skills at their own level in a relaxed and engaging Montessori classroom. The program includes gardening, art, cooking Thursdays, and water fun Fridays.

The weekly sessions will be organized around the following Montessori curriculum focus areas:

- **Session 1 (Stories & Art):** Come and enjoy read-alouds by fantastic authors such as Patricia Polacco, Jane Yolen and Dr. Seuss. We will explore their stories through arts, crafts, and cooking. You don't want to miss Patricia Polacco's famous Thunder Cake!
- **Session 2 (Ooey Gooley Science):** Let's make a mess and explore with some ooey gooley science. We will see if we can walk on eggs without breaking them, make slime, explore acids and bases, and have fun with many more science experiments.
- **Session 3 (Simple Machines):** Students learn about 6 types of simple machines through read alouds, experiments, and constructing their own simple machines.
- **Session 4 (Messy Olympics):** Get ready to make a mess! We will have a fun week of messy activities such as: egg toss, snack toss, water balloon piñata, and alphabet spaghetti.
- **Session 5 (STEM Science, Technology, Engineering & Math):** Children are presented with a challenge and using teamwork, creativity, and problem solving they will build a project that meets the challenge criteria.
- **Session 6 (Recipes Around the World):** Grab your passport, because every day we will be visiting another country through cooking, read-alouds and crafts.
- **Session 7 (Unplugged Coding):** Children will get an introduction to block-style coding by completing activities on paper using coding maps. At the end of the week they will program using Scratch Jr. If your child is already familiar with coding we find something more challenging for them.
- **Session 8 (Art Week):** Come create and learn about famous artists. Express your creativity by splatter painting like Jackson Pollock and geometric painting like Piet Mondrian.

In order to make our program available to as many children as possible, our enrollment schedule is flexible. You may enroll your child in any combination of one-week sessions. Enrollment is limited and available on a first-come, first-served basis, so please return this form as soon as possible to reserve your sessions.

Forms

- New students must complete the attached emergency medical authorization form. Be sure to list any allergies your child may have. Please bring the form with you the first week your child is attending. **Students will not be permitted to remain at school unless the form is provided.**

Items Needed

- All students will need to bring a snack and a packed lunch each day. Please provide a healthy lunch and drink (no soft drinks or candy permitted)
- Water bottle labeled- for outside
- Sunscreen and insect repellent should be applied at home. If you would like for us to reapply, please sign the permission slip on the sign in clip-board. If you want your own brand of sunscreen and/or bug spray, please bring it labeled with your child's name.

Morning Drop Off

- Please make sure to sign your child in each day with the time and your initials.
- Program starts at 8:30 a.m.
- If you have before care needs, you can drop off as early as 7:30 a.m.

Afternoon Pick Up

- Children will be dismissed either from the playground or the classroom. Please make sure to sign your child out each day with the time and your initials.
- Children may be picked up between **2:45 and 3:00**. Anything after 3:15 p.m. is considered Aftercare. All children must be picked up no later than 5:30 p.m.
- Please remember to take home your child's lunch box at the end of the day.

Tuition

- Tuition payments are due at the beginning of each week. Checks may be placed in the black tuition box located on the wall past the front desk. We also accept debit or credit cards; if you do not have a card on file you can pick up an authorization form at the front desk.

Fees: There is a one-time registration fee of \$35 due at the time of registration.

Payment for your session must be made by the beginning of each week. **If you wish to cancel a session, a 48-hour cancellation notice must be given or you will be charged for the full week.** This notice will allow staff time to readjust their planning and also give ample opportunity for a child on the wait list to secure that spot.

Aftercare will be available from 3:15 – 5:30 p.m., and will be billed at the rate of \$8.00 per hour. *(There is a 15 minute window after school before aftercare charges begin.)* If you need to use this service on a regular basis, the rate is \$175 per month for two hours of aftercare each day.

Parents of any child not picked up by 5:30 will be charged a late fee of \$1.00 per minute. Please call MSF immediately to notify the staff of your approximate arrival time if you are running late.

The above sessions are reserved for my child for the summer session. I understand that the registration fee is due with this form, tuition payments must be made no later than the start of each session, and that I will be billed and responsible for the reserved sessions regardless of whether I use them or not.
