



## Advisory Board

### Purpose

Oak Valley College's Advisory Board exists to promote and support the mission, vision, and values of the College. Board members commit to contributing time, talent, and resources. While there is no specific minimal requirement to serve, it is expected that each member actively engages in prayer, identifies and invites other prospective Board Members, serves as an ambassador to the community and prospective students/parents, and makes every effort to attend at least one meeting annually.

### Meetings

Oak Valley College will host at least one meeting per year for the Advisory Board. These functions serve as a means for the Board to collectively pray, network, hear about successes at the College, learn about new programs or services, and provide advice to senior leaders. In addition, current Board Members are encouraged to invite prospective Board Members to these events.

### Bylaws

The Bylaws govern the Board.

Advisory Board Members do not actively participate in the governance of the College, but there are still some core principles that Advisory Board members commit to:

- Positively and proactively support the College, the Board, its members, staff, and students

- Participate in at least one meeting/event per year

- Pray for the College, its leaders, and students

- Identify resources to support the College (prospective students or faculty members, donors, etc.)
