

# **2015 ABORTION STATISTICS**

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## Executive Summary

Pennsylvania has been monitoring and reporting on abortion data since 1975. Since 1980, the commonwealth has seen a decrease in the number of abortions performed. In 2015, there were 31,818 abortions performed in Pennsylvania.

Nearly half, or 15,820, of all abortions performed in Pennsylvania were to white women and 13,332 were to black or African-American women. Abortions to women of Hispanic origin accounted for 3,050, or 9.6 percent, of all abortions in 2015.

Over 87 percent, or 27,923, of the abortions performed in Pennsylvania in 2015 were to unmarried women.

As in previous years, the largest single age group having abortions was 20-24, accounting for 10,339, or 32.5 percent, of all 2015 abortions. Patients age 19 and under accounted for 9.8 percent and patients aged 17 and under accounted for 3.1 percent. Comparatively, in 2014, females age 19 and under accounted for 10.7 percent and females age 17 and under accounted for 3.3 percent.

Similar to 2014, 95 percent of the abortions performed in 2015 were on Pennsylvania residents. Residents of other states, territories and other countries accounted for just 1,586 abortions in 2015.

Of the abortions performed in 2015 in Pennsylvania, 82 percent were performed in four counties: Allegheny, Dauphin, Northampton and Philadelphia. Procedures took place at 21 hospitals and 19 non-hospital facilities statewide.

Nearly 40 percent of Pennsylvania residents receiving abortions were residents of Philadelphia County. Other counties with a large number of resident abortions included: Allegheny, 3,384; Delaware, 1,843; Montgomery, 1,585; Bucks, 1,101; and Berks, 1,026. Of all 67 counties, 26 (39 percent) showed a decrease in the number of resident abortions performed in 2015 compared to 2014.

In 2015, there were 151 reports of complications from abortions which were submitted by physicians, representing 7 percent fewer than the 162 reported in 2014. More than 71 percent of the complications were related to retained products of conception, 14 percent to bleeding, and 7 percent to infection.

Notes: The source for the number of abortions reported in Pennsylvania in 2015 is the "Report of Induced Termination of Pregnancy," which is an individual report filed for each procedure. The source for the complications data is "Abortions: Report of Complications," a separate reporting form completed by physicians who have provided medical care to a woman because of a complication resulting from an abortion or attempted abortion.

Unknowns are excluded from all calculations.
