Grandma (Crochet) Lap Blanket





Skill Level:

Size: Approximately 30" x 40"

Materials: 1600 yards worsted weight yarn

Hook: US G-6 (4mm)

Notions: Right side marker, tapestry needle

Gauge: 2 repeats and 11 rows = 4" in pattern stitch

Abbreviations:

Ch = Chain

Dc = Double crochet

Hdc = Half double crochet

Sc = Single crochet

Sk = Skip

Sp = Space

St = Stitch

Fan = 3dc, ch1, 3dc in same st

Note:

Although this pattern is reversible, the designated "right side" has more stitch definition. You will hold the yarn single stranded while crocheting this lap blanket.

The Pattern:

Ch 152

Set up row (RS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next ch, *sk 3 ch, fan in next ch, sk 3 ch, sc in next ch, ch 1, sk 1 ch, sc in next ch; rep from * to last 9 ch, sk 3 ch, fan in next ch, sk 3 ch, sc in last 2 ch, turn.

Row 2 (WS): Ch2 (counts a hdc), hdc in same st, *ch3, sc in center of fan, ch3, (hdc, ch1, hdc) in next ch1sp; rep from * ending last rep 2hdc in last sc, turn.

Row 3: Ch3, 3dc in same st, *sc in ch3sp, ch1, sc in next ch3sp, fan in ch1sp; rep from * across ending last rep sc in ch3sp, ch1, sc in last ch3sp, 4dc in turning ch, turn.

Row 4: Ch1, sc in same st, *ch3, (hdc, ch1, hdc) in next ch1sp, ch3, sc in center of fan; rep from * across, sc in turning ch, turn.

Row 5: Ch1, sc in first st, *sc in ch3sp, fan in ch1sp, sc in ch3sp, ch1; rep from * across, ending last rep sc in last ch3sp, sc in last sc, turn.

Repeat rows 2-5 until lap blanket measures 40". Cut yarn. Finish off.

Finishing:

Weave in ends.
