Bersano, 2010, DOCG Barolo, Italy
Red cherry, wild strawberry, rose, violet and sweet spices all come together on this straightforward elegant wine.
- Brunello Di Montalcino 'Riserva' WE 90 pts** 100
Rendola, 2004, DOCG Brunello di Montalcino, Italy
This Riserva poured as a brick red wine, on the palate this is all about red cherry & dark chocolate. Barrel aged, mature and lightly oaked.
- Cabernet Sauvignon 'Earthquake' WE 90 pts** 105
Michael David, 2013, Lodi, California
Flavours are deep and rich in this bold full bodied Cabernet, aroma of molasses, cherries, black plums & black currants, layers of fine tannins.

Argiolas, 2012, Sardegna, IGT, Italy
Warm, full bodied and intense ruby red blend of Bovale Sardo, Carignano, & Cannonau, offers a full bouquet of black fruit, cedar, black currants and chocolate.

This blend of Cabernet, Sangiovese, and Cabernet Franc has aromas of fresh herbs, dark fruit and tobacco, full bodied, concentrated currants, bright and beautiful.

Saturated with cherry, raspberry, spice and tobacco aromas, sticking balance between texture, acidity and refined tannins. Lingering finish.

Mastroberardino, 2008, Campania, Italy
A one off wine produced to honor the remarkable life of Antonio Mastroberardino, this wine is made from fruit only from the Montemarano vineyard. Intense colour and aroma

Antinori, 2013, IGT Toscana, Italy
Polished tannins and a finessed acidity reveal savory mineral notes that add persistence to the finish.

SORDO GIOVANNI BAROLO VERTICAL

Giorgio Sordo is a fifth generation winemaker from Piedmont, Italy, his farms 30 hectares of Nebbiolo are some of the regions finest vineyards, producing complex, ripe flavoured single vineyard wine. Matured in large oak barrels called 'botti' the wine is intense with complexity and length.

The strict production processes both in the vineyard and in the cellar have been handed down from generation to generation.
