2018 CP Exam Changes

The NALA Certifying Board provides oversight for the development and ongoing maintenance of the Certified Paralegal Examination. The Certifying Board approved the new structure for the CP examination effective January 2018 due to results of the recent job analysis, improvements in technology, and recent refinements by the National Commission for Certifying Agencies (NCCA). The new exam structure allows for a new format and content, quicker exam results, and more testing windows!

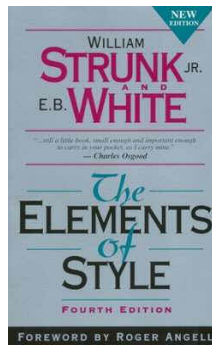


Tip Of The Month

Form the possessive singular of nouns by adding 's.

Follow this rule whatever the final consonant. Thus write,
Charles's friend
Burns's poems
the witch's malice

Exceptions are the possessives of ancient proper names ending in -es and -is, the possessive *Jesus's*, and such form as *for conscience's sake*, *for*



righteousness' sake. But such forms as *Moses' Laws*, *Isis' temple* are commonly replaced by:

the laws of Moses
the temple of Isis

The pronominal possessive *hers*, *its*, *theirs*, *yours*, and *ours* have no apostrophe. Indefinite pronouns, however, use the apostrophe to show possession.

one's rights
somebody else's umbrella

A common error is to write *it's* for *its*, or vice versa. The first is a contraction, meaning "it is." The second is a possessive.
