SANDRA PHILP MEMORIAL AWARD

Sandra Philp joined the Regina Highland Dancing Association in 1977 and served in numerous capacities, including President. She represented RHDA within the Scottish Society, was the Ambassador to the Mosaic Scottish Pavilion, and worked for several years on the executive of the Saskatchewan Highland Dance Association. Sandra was also an active member of the Regina Multicultural Council. Sandra was made a lifetime member of the Regina Highland Dancing Association. She passed away on January 3, 1991.

The Sandra Philp Memorial Award is presented in Sandra's memory to encourage dancers to participate in Saskatchewan competitions. It is presented to two Saskatchewan Premier Dancers who have received the highest points in the 14 & Under, and 15 and Over categories. The award includes a trophy and a \$50 scholarship.

Rules:

1. Dances included should be the number danced, if different than the number entered.
2. To be eligible, the dancer must have danced premier at all competitions included.
3. Each dancer is eligible to win this award only once.
4. Application form must be in the hands of the RHDA award coordinator by **November 30, 2016**.
5. The award will be presented at the RHDA spring Competition in March 2017.
6. Runner up points will be included in the calculation based on availability of results, and at the discretion of the RHDA. At a minimum, the runners up from RHDA, the Regina Highland Games, and the Provincials competitions will be included.
7. Winning dancers to be presented with a trophy which is shared between winners, and a scholarship.
8. Dancers age will be as of May 31st.
9. Points will be accumulated at all ScotDance Canada sanctioned Saskatchewan competitions between September and June of the year.
10. Points are awarded as follows: 1 point for every dance entered, including choreography, 4 points for winning an aggregate trophy, 2 points for being first runner up for an aggregate trophy. Dances restricted to only specific groups of Saskatchewan dancers will not be included.
