**Mildred L. Day School**



Construction on Mildred L. Day School is right on schedule. 95% of the foundation walls have been installed and we expect the remaining portions to be completed in the next couple of weeks. In addition to the underground electrical and plumbing lines, the tubing for the radiant floor heat in the academic wing is in the process of being installed. The construction schedule calls for the pouring of the concrete slab in the academic wing to occur on Monday, May 16<sup>th</sup>. The gym floor slab will be poured the same week, followed by the delivery and erection of the steel frame. The students are learning volumes about large-scale construction projects!

By now you have likely seen the portable classrooms that line the front lawn at Kennebunk High School.
