

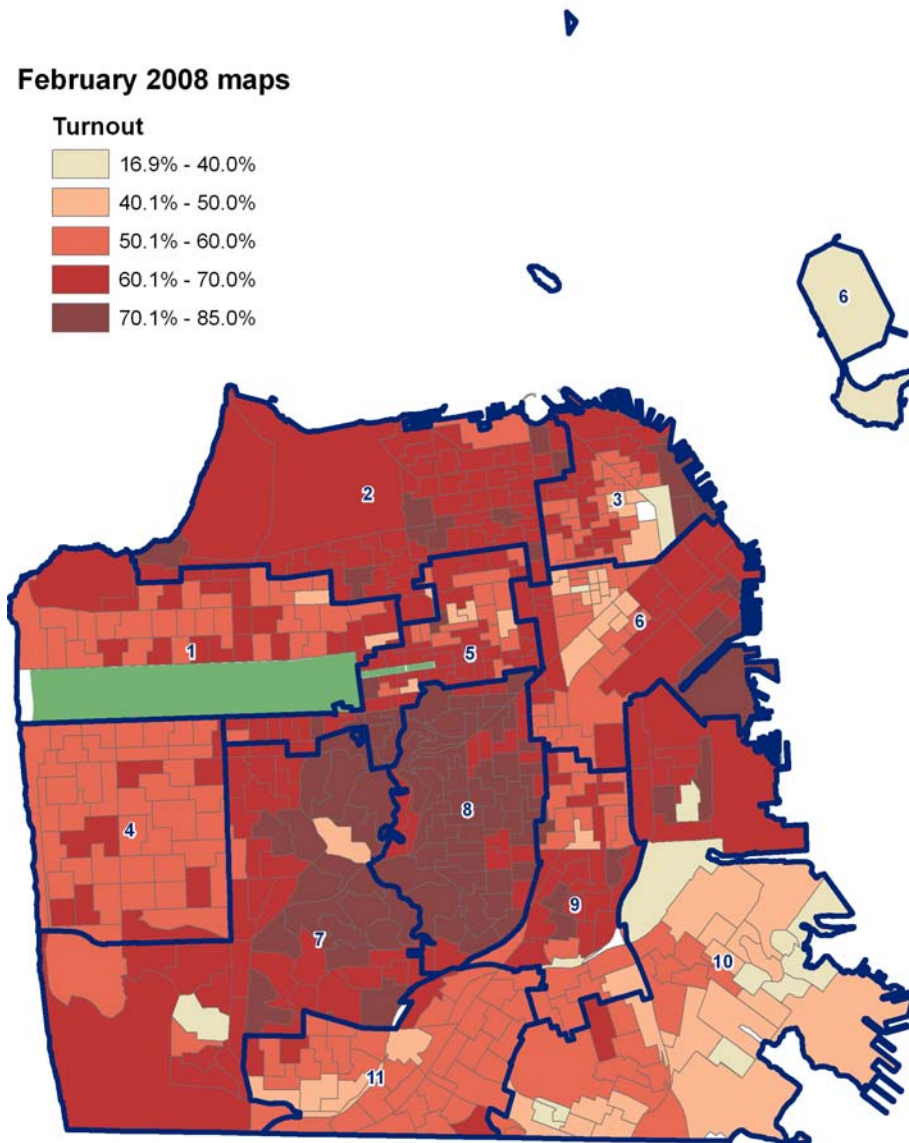
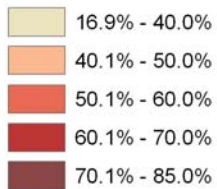
Maps from the February, 2008 Primary in San Francisco
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Just a few maps of the recent 2-08 Primary. I show Turnout, the percentages for Barack Obama and Hillary Clinton, and the percentage yes for the recent city props A, B, and C. This is from the preliminary SOV, but the tallies will be real close to the final SOV.

Map 1 – Turnout. No surprises here, given the very high Democratic Party turnout. D8, as usual, dominated, followed closely by D7. Oh look, there's D2.

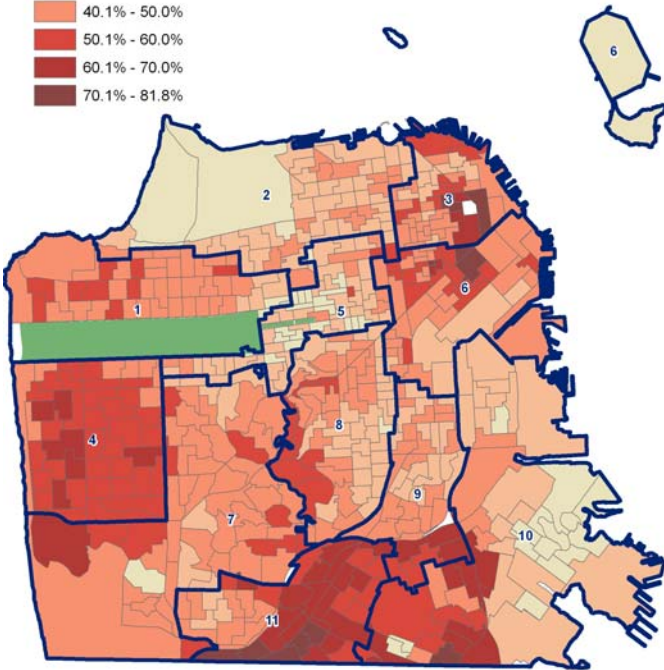
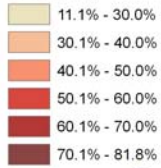

Maps 2 and 3 – percentages for Clinton and Obama, respectively. Set to the same scale. Clinton did better in the more blue-collar and Asian areas of D11, D4, and parts of D3 and D6, while Obama did real well in the more liberal areas of, well, everywhere else. This pretty much aligns with much of the primary results in the rest of the US. Solves the D2 mystery.

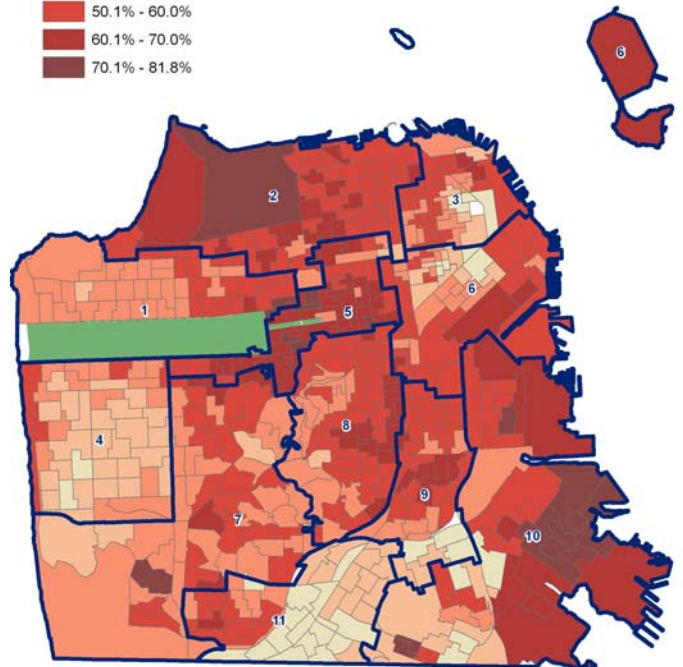
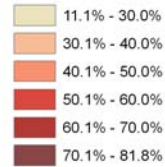

% Clinton



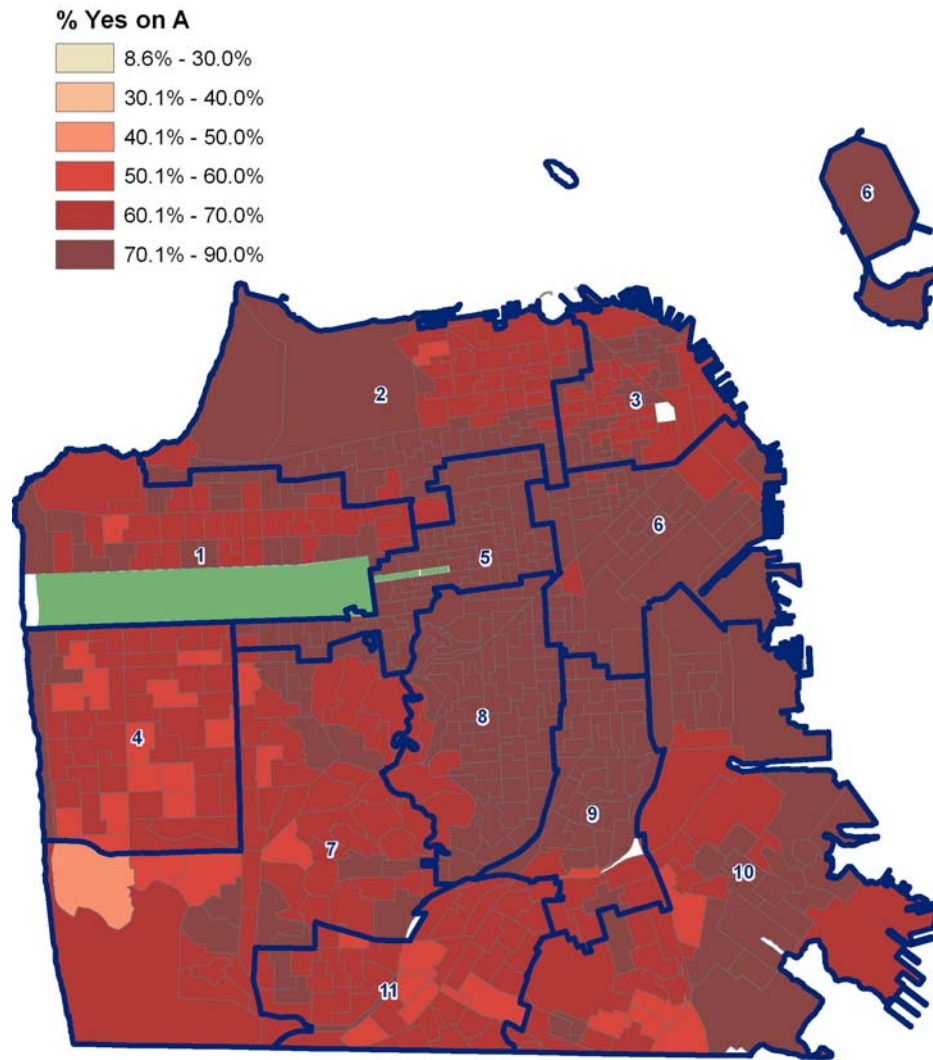

Map 4 – Yes on A (Parks Bond).¹ Now who doesn't like parks?

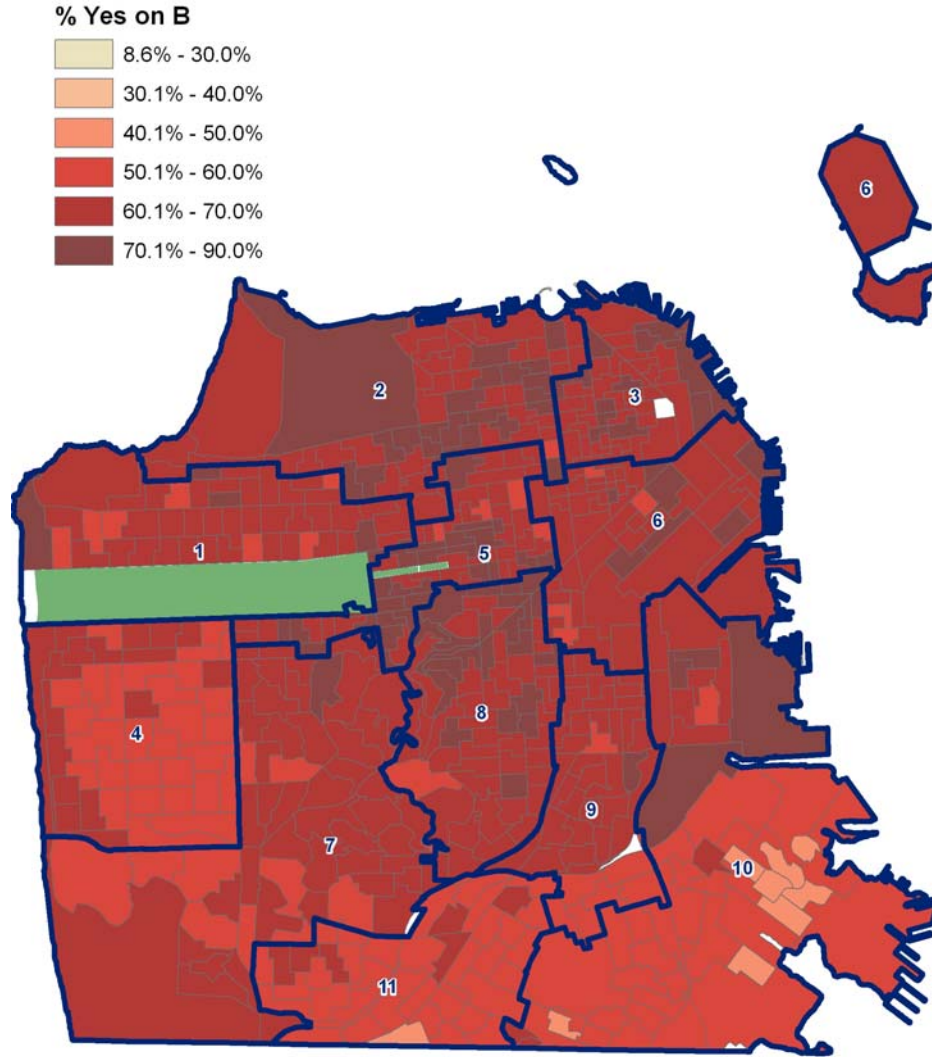
