February 2-12, 2018 Trip Overview



The group will be based in Matanzas, where the Evangelical Theological Seminary will host us, but will also stay in Havana and Santa Clara. Along the way we will be learning from church leaders and explore partnership possibilities with congregations of the Presbyterian Reformed Church in Cuba. We can absorb the history and culture that shape the ministry context for our partners to the south and discern how changes in relations between our nations will affect them.

The estimated basic trip cost of \$2,150 includes international airfare, Cuba visa, food, transportation, and lodging in Cuba. It does not include your domestic travel to/from Tampa or overnight in Tampa which is required for the early departures to Havana.

Is this kind of trip legal?

Yes, we will travel under a general license from the U.S. government authorizing travel to Cuba for religious purposes. You will need a passport, and we will obtain your Cuba visa.
