108 Orvieto Classico Campogrande, Antinori Umbria 2014

Medium rich, earthy, citrus fruit, with a bitter almond finish. 32

109 Gavi DOCG "Principessa Gavia" Vigne Regali Piedmont 2012

Single vineyard 100% Cortese, crisp and dry minerality with citrus, pineapple and green apple. 33

110 Soave, Anselmi San Vincenzo Veneto 2012/13

80% Garganega, 15 % Chardonnay, crisp, scents of minerals, apple and lemon blossoms. Dry finish. 36

111 Soave, Classico DOC Pieropan, Veneto 2014

Organically grown in volcanic soils producing delicate aromas of almond blossoms and marzipan. Zingy acidity, and a good depth of fruit. Long on the palate. 34

113 Sauvignon Castel Del Monte DOC, Rivera "Terre al Monte", Apulia, 2013

100% Sauvignon Blanc. Aromas of flowers and grass with excellent fruit and almond finish. 38

116 Pinot Grigio, Livio Felluga, Colli Orientali del Friuli, 2013

Crisp with complex notes of jasmine and magnolia layered with white peach, golden apple and acacia honey, finishing with a pleasant mineral note. 36

117 Chardonnay IGT Toscana, Castello Banfi "Fontanelle" 2013 Montalcino

Fruit forward aromas with spicy notes of vanilla. Soft and dry on the palate with hints of apple, peach and apricot surrounded by light vanilla. Barrique barrel fermented and aged. 39

120 Verdicchio del Castelli di Jesi Classico DOC Lucchetti Marches 2010

Highly fragrant with delicate aromas of flowers, fruit and cut grass. 36

121 Gavi di Davi DOCG, Villa Sparina Piedmont 2012

Classic Gavi in authentic bottle. Floral nose with peach, pear, lemony citrus flavors and a hint of wet stone. 38

104 Pinot Grigio IGT Arancio Sicily 2012

Aroma of magnolia and citrus, with a fresh and elegant minerality and natural acidity. 34

107 Pinot Grigio, Riff, Alois Lageder Veneto 2013

Aromas of citrus fruits; crisp, semi-dry and fruity; long on the palette. 34

114 Pinot Grigio IGT, San Angelo Tuscany 2012/13

Lush tropical fruit aromas and flavors, balanced with crisp citrus notes. 38

115 Pinot Grigio, Valdadige, DOC Barone Fini, 2013

Aromas of subtle floral notes and citrus with ripe juicy flavors of honeydew and apple. Bright acidity and crisp minerality. 32

105 Verdicchio U Ronchi 2014

Crisp and light with pineapple, pear and apple flavors intermingled with orange zest and almond notes. 39

WHITE WINES: PACIFIC NORTHWEST AND CALIFORNIA

Our list of Pacific Northwest and California Chardonnays offers an exciting example of how the distinct California, Oregon and Washington regions express the characteristics of this noble varietal. Other selections are hand-picked to complement the Ambrosia menu.

150 Meritage Blanc, Beringer, Knights Valley Napa 2010

A blend of Semillon, Sauvignon Blanc, Chardonnay and Viognier. This beautifully blended wine has layered aromas of lemon curd, citrus, honeydew melon and a light smoky spiced oak. 35

152 "Conundrum," Caymus, California 2013

Chardonnay, Sauvignon Blanc, Semillon, Viognier and Muscat. A wine that escapes definition, maybe, but this full-flavored white will stand up to any meal. 38

154 Chardonnay, Beringer, Private Reserve Napa Valley 2011/12

Color is deep gold. Aroma of ripe fruits, dry on the palate. Layers of smooth yet complex fruits and flowers. Finish is long and seamless. WS: 93pts. 58

156 Chardonnay, Château St. Michelle "Canoe Ridge" Columbia Valley 2013

Buttery, tropical fruit tones layered with hazelnut and spice. 42

160 Chardonnay, Hendry Barrel Fermented Napa Valley 2011

A legendary Chardonnay. Very rich with Napa fruit flavors and excellent structure, finishing with a spicy, toasty oak. 52

163 Chardonnay, "Stainless" Chamisal, Central Coast, 2012

Clean and crisp with bright acidity and minerality. Notes of pineapple, apple, pear and citrus with hints of figs and stone. No oak or malolactic fermentation. WE: 90pts. 35

165 Chardonnay, Grgich Hills Estates, Napa 2011

Crisp with rich flavors of apple, honeydew melon and fig with a hint of baked brioche. Bracingly acidic on the long finish. 100% non-malolactic fermentation. 64

166 Chardonnay, La Crema, Sonoma Coast 2013

Bright ripe fruit and acidity with vanilla and caramel shortbread richness. Mary's favorite. 42

170 Chardonnay, Sonoma Cutrer Estate, Russian River Ranches 2013

Lively citrus flavors. 42

171 Chardonnay, Newton, Napa 2013

Rich and balanced with notes of pear, baked apple, peach and tangerine with hints of vanilla, nutmeg and clove. 42

174 Fume Blanc, Ferrari Carano, Sonoma Valley 2013

Rich and lively with fig, pear and citrus flavors. David recommends. 36

175 Pinot Gris, Archery Summit "Vireton" 2013, Willamette Valley

Juicy pineapple, fig and apple with lively acidity and mouth feel. 38

180 Pinot Gris, King Estate, Lorane Valley 2014

Dry, ripe, forward fruit. Rich and long. A distinctive and unique Oregon wine. 36

181 Chardonnay, Joel Gott, Monterey 2014

Intense bouquets of orange blossom and green apple, followed by citrus and pear flavors, mineral notes and a lively finish. 36

182 Pinot Gris, King Estate Domaine, Lorane Valley 2013

Well-balanced, with pear and citrus tones. Heather's Favorite. 48

184 Pinot Gris, Silvan Ridge, Willamette Valley 2013

Full bodied, ripe fruit with excellent structure. One of the finest wineries in Eugene. 36

185 Chardonnay, Rombauer, Carneros 2013

A rich and full bodied with classic apple, pear and butter character with just a hint of oak. Bright, vibrant tropical fruit aromas flow from the glass. Underlying grapefruit and lime add depth and character to the aroma. 58

186 Pinot Gris, Four Graces, Willamette Valley 2014

Bright, fresh and crisp with kiwi and lemon aromas followed by apple, gooseberry and key lime on the palate. Minerality and acidity balanced by soft floral aromas and a silky, full-bodied texture. 38

187 Chardonnay, Dry Creek "Foggy Oaks" Russian River 2010

Citrus, melon and tropical fruit with mineral notes. Rich body and finish due to partial malo and French oak. 38

191 Fumé Blanc, Grgich Hills Estate, Napa 2012

Ripe, elegant flavors of passion fruit, lemon grass and a hint of mineral at the end of the long finish. 58

192 Sauvignon Blanc, Simi, Alexander Valley 2014

This refreshing and brightly acidic wine at first appears delicate but then reveals nuance after nuance, finishing with a long, lingering impression of citrus and mineral notes. 34

SPARKLING WINES

206 Brut, Tattinger, La Française, Champagne, France NV

Classic, tight and firm. 75

208 Brut, Argyle, Willamette Valley 2012

Yellow summer fruits, baked apple and ginger spice up front. The middle palate is creamy concentrated and fleshy. The long finish is enlivened by mouth-fitting volcanic structure and lively acidity. 48

212 Moscato d'Asti, Saracco, Piedmont 2014

The beautiful aromas of the grapes are enhanced by a light frizziness and the sweetness of the natural sugar. 34

213 Prosecco di Valdobbiadene, Trevisiol, Veneto

Extra dry. This sparkling wine has subtle flower and fruit aromas that are deliciously light and playful on the palate. A peachy softness with a simple minerality that does not overwhelm with sweetness. 35

214 Brut Champagne, Dom Perignon, Vintage Epernay, France 2004/1006

Floral candied fruit with toasted notes. Opulent and silky. W.S. 95 235

216 Brut, Veuve Clicquot Ponsardin, Champagne, France NV

Creamy, rich and round. 65

217 Brut Rose Talento, Rotari, Trentino, Italy

A combination of Chardonnay and Pinot Noir, produced in the traditional Metodo Classico style, from the heart of the Dolomites in Northern Italy. Full, fragrant and pleasantly balanced. 31

218 Brut Reserve Champagne NV, Pol Roger, France

Pale gold with a very fine bead; flowery, delicately toasty aroma with fruit. Complexity beautifully balanced with a dry, harmonious finish. 90pts. WS. WE. Vinous 80

219 Brut, Scharffenberger Mendocino NV

Fresh brioche and lemon curd mingle in a effervescent melange ending in a crisp, clean finish. 38

220 Brut Rose, Graham Beck NV South Africa

60% Chardonnay, 40% Pinot Noir from South Africa. Méthod Cap Classique. Aromas of raspberries and cherries. Subtle red berry flavors enlivened by bright acids. Brisk. 35

RED WINES: PIEDMONT, ITALY

Bordering Switzerland in the northwest, Piedmont is the home of some of Italy's most regal red wines.

Nebbiolo is the noble grape of both Barolo and Barbaresco, producing wines of great finesse and complexity. Barbera and Dolcetto from the area are also wines of notable class.

317 Barolo Cabatto DOCG, Tenuta La Volta 2012

Full-bodied, classic old school Barolo, with hints of tar and roses. 65

319 Barbaresco DOCG Ceretto, Asij 2011

Ruby red with orange reflections, penetrating, full and varied, reminiscent of wild berries. Rich body, good texture, the tannins are silky and fully developed. 85

320 Barbaresco Gallina, DOCG, La Spinetta 2008

Ripe fruit aromas and flavors of blueberry and boysenberry are accented by flowers and Asian spices. 3 Glasses Gambero Rosso, 94 Suckling, 92 WS, 94 Vinous. 165

321 Barolo "Pressenda" DOCG, Marziano Abbona 2005

From the Monforte d'Alba commune of Barolo. Intense and ethereal aromas of dried roses, tar, and violets. Warm wood and spice notes. A full body comprised of sweet fruit with a long, caressing finish. 91WS 89

322 Barolo DOCG, Pertinace 2009

Lush and complex bouquet with hints of sweet spice, ripe fruit and vanilla. Great depth on the palate with dried fruit and herbs. Well balanced, structured and smooth. 75

323 Barbera Muscatel, Brezza 2008

Fruit forward, cedar and spice. Perfect for Zinfandel and Syrah lovers. Deep and complex. 48

324 Barbera d'Alba, Bruna Grimaldi 2012

Undertones of cocoa and espresso with a classic finish and a vein of texture. 46

325 Barbera DOC, Fontanafredda "Briccotondo" 2012

Fresh and approachable with plenty of red fruit flavors. Soft and distinctively plush on the palate. 42

326 Barbera del Monferrato DOC, Marchesi "Maraia" diBarolo 2013

Perfume of wild berries, currants and sour black cherry combined on the palate with a light hint of vanilla, toasted oak and vibrant acidity. 35

346 Barbera d'Asti Superiore DOC, Tenuta Olim Bauda Niza, 2010

Beautiful nose of dark cherries, licorice, tar and some smoke. Medium-full body with pretty high acidity and medium silky tannins. Needs aeration complexity. The wine is very balanced and has a long finish. Great Barbera. 54

RED WINES: PIEDMONT, ITALY

330 Barolo Serralunga d'Alba DOCG Giacomo Conterno, "Cascina Francia" 1993

Dark, ruby, purple nuances, roasted herbs, tobacco and dried cherries. Mellow and round in the mouth. 370

331 Barolo Serralunga d'Alba, DOCG, Fontanafredda 2013

A clear-cut, intense nose with overtones of vanilla, spices, withered roses and under brush; its taste is dry, but soft, full-bodied, velvety and well balanced, and is very long-lasting. 79

333 Barolo DOCG, Mirafiore 2010

Aromas of rose petals and dried cherries give way to flavors of plum, black cherry, spice with tight grained tannins and a firm structure and a long, complex finish. 59

334 Barolo Cannubi DOCG, Brezza 2009

Classic Barolo from one of the best vintages in decades. Pretty, aromatic nose of flowers and spices followed by flavors of small red fruits, raspberries and minerals. Fine and ripe tannins. 79

338 Barbera d'Alba DOC, Giacosa Fratelli "Bussia" 2012

From the famed Bussia vineyard in Barolo. Fruity with hints of fresh berries, spices and tobacco. 38

339 Barolo DOCG, Marcarini "Brunate" 2009

"Soft and supple. Full bodied with ripe black cherries, chocolate liqueur and hints of citrus zest. A wine of substantial length and elegance."
-Robert Parker. WA: 91 pts, WE: 93 pts. 80

346 Barbera d'Asti Superiore, Tenuta Olim Bauda Niza, 2010

Beautiful nose of dark cherries, licorice, tar and some smoke. Medium-full body with pretty high acidity and medium silky tannins. Needs aeration. The wine is very balanced and has a pretty long finish. Great Barbera. 49

351 Dolcetto Dogliani DOCG "Papa Celso" Marziano Abbona 2012

A single vineyard Dolcetto Superiore from a 12 acre parcel. Complex aromas of dark cherry, cloves and pepper. 48

352 Dolcetto d'Alba DOC, Enzo Bogliatti "Tiglineri" 2012

Opaque in color, deep rub with slightly violet edges. The nose is rich with notes of blackberry, coconut curry powder and liquorice. Soft tannins with hints of charcoal and plum on the finish. 45

353 Langhe DOC "Buio," Enzo Bogliatti 2012

From the famous region of La Morra. Intense and complex bouquet with mineral, floral and notes of fried hay with balanced oak. Full-bodied and crisp on the palette with soft tannins and a vibrant long finish. 75

354 Gattinara DOCG Travaglini 2009

All Nebbiolo. Undertones of dried flowers and very ripe fruits. Big, chewy, yet smooth and complex with a rich finish. Very underrated. David Recommends. 49

RED WINES: TUSCANY

Although Chianti is the best known area in Tuscany and Sangiovese the most important grape, this region has far more to offer. Brunello (a superior clone of Sangiovese) is Tuscany's wine of greatest stature, producing wines of legendary power and longevity. The Cabernet Sauvignon or Merlot based wines aged in small French oak barrels, often called "Super Tuscans," give Tuscany another dimension with their powerful concentration and luxurious richness.

356 Cepparello, Isole E Olena 2011

Subtle, elegant aromas of blackberry, cherry and licorice. Very powerful on the palate. 105

357 Brunello di Montalcino DOCG, Caprili 2008

Expressive and focused aromas of red currants, black cherries and licorice. Finely balanced between and intensity of velvet on the palate and a finish with length and weight. 75

358 Brunello di Montalcino DOCG, La Fortuna 2008

Ripe fruit aromas, dark chocolate, unusually open and ready to be drunk. WA: 90 pts. 85

359 Brunello di Montalcino DOCG, Il Poggione 2007

Roses and violets, dark raspberries, spices and mint all take shape in this 2007 that impresses for its freshness and pure energy. 95pts. Vinous & Tazer, 94 WA, 92 WS, 91 WE, 94 Suckling 135

360 Brunello di Montalcino DOCG, Canalicchio 2008

Full-bodied, layers of fruit and raisins. Complex yet very smooth for its youth. 75

361 Rosso di Montalcino DOC, Castello Banfi 2011

Intense, fresh and fruity bouquet with typical violet, cherry and plum undertones. Gentle, yet full and soft on the palette with surprising length. 44

363 Rosso di Montepulciano, DOC Poliziano 2013

Sangiovese with 20% Merlot. The baby brother to Vine Nobile, one of Tuscany's most illustrious red wines. Cherry, blackberry and velvety tannins. 38

364 Rosso di Montalcino DOCG, Siro Pacenti 2010

A big wine. Rich and dark, firm tannins, massive structure. WS calls Giancarlo Pacenti "The greatest winemaker in the appellation." 58

365 Bolgheri Rosso DOC, Donna Olimpia 1898 2010

Cabernet, Merlot, Petit Verdot and Cabernet Franc; clean, polished feel with tightly woven forest-fruit and mineral tones, soft cherry and tangy herb endnotes. 90pts. WE 48

369 Chianti Classico DOCG, Petroio 2011

Deep, earthy Sangiovese fruit notes of black cherries and firm, food-friendly tannins. 38

370 Chianti Classico DOCG Riserva, La Maialina 2007/08

Inviting aromas of black cherries, plums and sweet spices, with notes of roses and black pepper, elegant and lush on the palate with ripe round tannins and a long finish. WS: 92 pts. 45

RED WINES: TUSCANY

371 Chianti Classico, Podere Ciona 2008/09

Aged in French oak barique barrels for 18 months. Aromas of cherry and blackberry with earthy beets co-mingle with a taut, finely structured Sangiovese and Merlot blend that could age for another ten years. 49

372 Chianti Classico DOCG, Isole E Olena 2012

Aromas of smoky black fruit and plum. Medium-bodied with fine, delicate tannins and a nice fruity finish with a twist of milk chocolate. 48

374 Rosso di Montalcino DOC, Il Poggione 2013

Sweet cherries, raspberries and pomegranate. A fabulous value from one of the highest regarded Brunello producers. Vinous:91 pts. WS:90 pts. 48

375 Barco Reale di Carmignano DOC Capezzana 2012

Concentrated with sweet dense tannins and a lush velvety texture with ripe blackberry and dark cherry flavors mingling on the finish. . 45

376 Chianti Classico DOC, Vignamaggio Estate 2012

Well balanced, fruit forward. A beautiful wine from one of Tuscany's oldest wineries. 40

378 Vino Nobile di Montepulciano, Corte Alla Flora, 2012

Intense, clear and fragrant fruit aromas of raspberry, with a soft and velvety flavor followed by pleasant tannins. 42

379 Chianti Classico DOCG Riserva, Castello Monsanto, 2011

Rich, intense and complex with notes of black cherry and spice. Full bodied on the palette with rich red berry fruit complimenting a backbone of tannins. WA: 91 pts, WS: 90 pts. 48

380 Bolgheri DOC, Ornellaia 2010/11

Deep and intense wine. Confit style cherry-pie fruit, with a smoky character that's full on the palate with plenty of structure. 265

381 Guildaberto, Tenuta San Guido 2011

A deep, vibrant purple with intense aromas full and ripe with dark cherry and plumb fruits and notes of spice. Wonderfully structures and balances on the palate with flavors of wild berries and herbs. 85

384 Fontalloro, Fattoria di Felsina 2010

100% Sangiovese a Super-Tuscan. Fresh and chunky red. Well structured and balanced. Chocolate and ripe cherries on the nose. Medium to full body, with soft silky tannins and a long, clean fruit finish. WS: 90 pts. David recommends. 88

385 Chianti Classico DOC, Casa Emma 2012

Beautifully harmonious flavors of classic earthy yet sun-drenched Tuscan Sangiovese grapes. The altitude of the vineyards provides an intensity and complexity of flavors. Very small production. 39

386 Tignanello Toscana IGT, Piero Antinori 2011

Piero Antinori's best. Very limited in supply. Big, long, and intense. A great representation of how Tuscan wine should be. 130

304 Barbaresco, Gaja 2010

308 Costa Russi Langhe DOC, Gaja 2006

Nebbiolo with 5% Barbera from the Costa Russi vineyard in Barbaresco. Wild berry with beautiful background renderings of smoke and graphite. Elegant. 95 pts WE, 92 & WS.450

312 Promis, Gaja, Ca’ Marcanda 2012

Bright and fruity with a jammy nose! A delightful wine that combines the elegance and suppleness of merlot and Syrah with a austerity of Sangiovese. 85

337 Barolo, Gaja, “Sperrs” Langhe, DOC 1996/2005

“Complex nose of tar, licorice, and new oak. Superbly well balanced with tremendous length. Dark fruit, plum, prune and cassis. Long, fresh finish.” -Robert Parker. WA: 91 pts. WE: 93pts. 450

366 Magari, Gaja, Ca’ Marcanda, Toscana, IGT 2010/11

Gaja’s first Bordeaux blend of Cabernet, Cabernet Franc and Merlot. Fruity, subtle texture with full body. Young, yet very approachable. W.S. 90 Parker 94. 115

368 Sito Moresco, Gaja, Langhe, DOC 2007/08

Roasted black fruits, and roasted herbs, with complex notes of cloves and finely tanned leather. It is smooth and richly textured, with an approachable tannic backbone and correct acidity. A finely structure, graceful and stylish, almost gliding across the palette. 88

RED WINES: CAMPANIA, ABRUZZO, UMBRIA, VENETO AND SICILY

Valpolicella is the name given to a blend of native grapes, of which Corvina Veronese is the key component, especially in Amarone and Recioto, since the drying process seems to bring out its best.

388 Amarone della Valpolicella DOC Villa Arvedi, Bertani Valpantena 2011

Intense purple in color, the nose is deep and expressive with raisins, cherries and wild berries. Full bodied yet approachable. A house favorite. 85

389 Amarone della Valpolicella Classico DOC, Allegrini 2009

A true classic of the appellation with imposing structure and depth, as much as in its aromas of mature fruit and spices, as on the palate, where the alcohol is sustained by the right degree of acidity and refined tannins. 3 Bicchieri, 96pts Decanter, 93 WA, 92 WE & WS. 115

390 Amarone Valpolicella DOC, Righetti 2010

A family run winery since 1904, this Amarone shows a classic bouquet of dried fruit and almonds with a hint of anise. Extremely rich flavors with a long, smooth finish. 58

392 Valpolicella Classico Superiore, DOC, Ripasso "Solane", Santi 2010

Intense bouquet of cloves, vanilla, cherry jam and almonds. In the mouth, the wine is full, warm and harmonious, with an elegant finish. 38

393 Pallazzo dell Torre, IGT Veronese, Allegrini 2010

Rich, full-bodied, great concentration. A perfect compliment to our traditional Spaghetti Bolognese. 44

395 Gulfi Cerasuolo di Vittoria DOCG, 2013

A lively blend of organically grown Nero d'avola and frappato. Bright cherry and raspberry flavors blend into an earthy but smooth finish. Great with seafood, risotto and tomato based dishes. 42

396 Gulfi, Rossjbleo, 2010

A medium bodied red wine made purely from organically grown Nero d'Avola. Warm spice and earth aromas open into deep blueberry and plumb flavors with a lingering finish. Swirl and enjoy with antipasti or mushroom dishes. Darryl recommends. 40

399 Montepulciano d'Abruzzo DOC, Quattro Mani 2013

Attilio Pagli is one of the "four hands" acclaimed wine-makers in this project to showcase traditional wines, grown sustainably and bottled at the source. Fresh and fruity with smooth flavors of currant, strawberry and raspberry. 35

401 Montepulciano, La Quercia Reserva 2013

This is an example of what happens when you match low-yield winemaking expertise with a prolific growing zone. Made by winemaker Antonio Lamona, this is one of the most expressive and balanced Montepulcianos around. This wine is also 100% organic, and delivers as a wine that takes no shortcuts. 34

PINOT NOIR: THE WILLAMETTE VALLEY

The Willamette Valley is recognized as one of the premier Pinot Noir producing regions in the world. Protected from the Pacific storms by the Coastal Range and from the dry, high heat of the desert by the Cascades, our valley boasts the ideal conditions for the picky, cool-climate Pinot.

This is our local wine and we have reason to be proud of it.

406 Pinot Noir, Broadley Estate 2013

50% new and 50% one-year-old oak. A very big and firm Pinot with a fabulous, gripping texture. 48

408 Pinot Noir, Broadley "Claudia's Choice" 2012/13

100% whole cluster. Single vineyard, big extracted forward and long, ripe fruit. 75

410 Pinot Noir, Domaine Drouhin 2013

Some toasty oak and cherry fruit. Big, rich, silky and full. Long spicy finish. 68

412 Pinot Noir, Broadley Vineyards, "Jessica" 2013

414 Pinot Noir, King Estate 2013

Black cherries, with a long and complex finish, King Estate has established itself as a definitive Eugene winery. 48

422 Pinot Noir, Archery Summit, Red Hills Estate, 2011/12

RED WINES: MERLOT AND CABERNET SAUVIGNON

For many, Cabernet Sauvignon is the king of wine grapes, and the Cabernets from certain vineyards in Napa, Sonoma and other areas of California are among the very best anywhere. In less than thirty years, California wineries making Cabernet Sauvignon have gone from candidates to authorities, so that even wine makers in Bordeaux are studying (and copying) the styles and methods of California Cabernet.

In Washington's Columbia, Yakima and Walla Walla appellations, these "Bordeaux Varieties" are world-class. With the intense hot days and cold nights of these regions, the wines develop great fruit and structure. More and more, Merlots and Cabernets from Washington's hot arid climate are also attaining this high quality.

502 Merlot, Abacela Umpqua Valley 2011

Wonderful aroma of black currants and spice. 42

762 Zinfandel, Girard Old Vine, Napa Valley 2012

Fruit sourcing from century-old valley floor vineyards ensures rich flavor extraction, a fruit-forward palate and wonderful layers of complexity from multiple soil types. Kirsch, raspberry, red licorice and dark plums with subtle notes of tobacco, dried hay and cedar. WE: 90 pts. 49

720 Tempranillo. Abacela, Umpqua Cuvee, Umpqua Valley 2012

A big, dark wine, ripe brambly and stone fruits with leather and floral notes on the nose. Juicy blackberry and plum with vanilla, spice and licorice on the palate. Medium to heavy bodied with firm, round tannins. A house favorite. 49

721 Petite Sirah, Girard, Napa Valley 2012

Aromatics of olive, anise, coffee, thyme and dark fruits; the palate showcases a rich mouthful of bittersweet chocolate, espresso, blackberry cobbler, dusty cinnamon and mocha. Th finish evolves with bright acidity and inky tannins. WA: 93 pts, WE: 92 pts, WS: 90 pts. 53

RED WINES: IBERIA, SPAIN

Top quality, food friendly wines from the Iberian Peninsula have been recognized since at least the Roman era. Typically blended from indigenous grape varieties such as Tempranillo, Touriga, Grenache, Carignan and Graciano, these wines have a capacity to age long periods or to be enjoyed young.

In the 1980s, wine makers moved away from the traditional extended aging in old oak, toward a deeper, fruit-forward international style, using newer oak barrels and at times adding small amounts of Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon. We find these wines to be a natural companion to our style of regional cuisine.

803 Tempranillo, Muga, Rioja Reserva unfiltered 2010

Fruit sourcing from century-old valley floor vineyards ensures rich flavor extraction, a fruit-forward palate and wonderful layers of complexity from multiple soil types. Kirsch, raspberry, red licorice and dark plums with subtle notes of tobacco, dried hay and cedar. WE: 90 pts. 59

806 Tempranillo Cruz de Alba Crianza, Ribera del Duero, 2008

100% Tempranillo, aromatics of ripe red and black berries with a mix of sweet spices surrounded by fresh tones of mint. Massive fruit on the palate with hints of juicy red plums, smoke and mineral at the background. WA: 90 pts. 48

804 Priorat, Bodegas La Cartuja DOC 2012

A very silky wine with plum fruits and rich vanilla tones. A leader in the “new style” of Rioja. Aged in French Oak-lands for 8 months. Priorat has been producing wines since the Medieval times. IWR: 92pts. 48

805 Priorat Marco Abella “Loidana,” 2009

Family farmed since the 15th century. Estate grown, biodynamically farmed fruit from the highest altitude vineyards in all of the Priorat. Grenache, Carignan, Cinsault and Syrah. Red fruit and black berries with hints of spice. 56

809 Tempranillo, Rioja Grand Reserva, Faustino 2001

A top example of an aged Rioja. Powerful yet elegant with a complex array of flavors. Delicate use of creamy oak and spicy, leathery notes with ripe bramble fruits leading to a mineral finish. 68

812 Tempranillo, El Coto Rioja Crianza 2010

100% Tempranillo shows layers of fresh raspberries, cherry, cedar and spice typical of a classically styled Rioja. Vanilla, leather and a long, soft finish. 36

816 Garnacha, Bodegas Alto Moncayo, Campo de Borja 2011/12

Sweet perfume of blackberries and toasty oak with an opulent, fleshy, fruity palate, plenty of muscle and potency with a long silky finish. Al King recommends. 94

817 Garnacha, Vinas Viejas, Las Rocas Calatayud Spain, 2009

The spicy, rich cranberry bouquet is followed by dark cherry flavors, an excellent structure and elegant oak. Round and full in the mouth, with supple tannins and a fruit-filled finish. 48

VINTAGE PORTS

Port has changed very little since its origins in the 1800s. The grapes are picked, crushed and fermented quickly. After about two days the must is fortified with neutral spirit, which arrests the fermentation and leaves some sweetness. While other kinds of Port are aged for many years, vintage Port is bottled unfiltered after only two years.
