Medium richness. Earthy flavors with citrus fruit and a bitter almond finish. 35
- 109 Gavi DOCG, “Principessa Gavia,” Piedmont 2013**
Single vineyard 100% Cortese. Crisp and dry minerality with hints of pineapple and green apple. Pairs well with seafood or chicken. 33
- 121 Gavi di Gavi DOCG, Villa Sparina, Piedmont 2012**
Classic Gavi in an authentic bottle with a floral nose. Peach, pear and lemony citrus flavors with a hint of wet stone. 39
- 110 Soave, Anselmi “San Vincenzo,” Veneto 2014**
80% Garganega, 15% Chardonnay. Crisp, with scents of minerals, apples and lemon blossoms. Dry finish on the palate. 36

RED WINES: PIEDMONT, ITALY

Bordering Switzerland in the northwest, Piedmont is the home of some of Italy's most regal red wines. Nebbiolo is the noble grape of both Barolo and Barbaresco, producing wines of great finesse and complexity. Barbera and Dolcetto from the area are also wines of notable class.

351 Dolcetto Dogliani DOCG, "Papa Celso," Marziano Abbona 2012/2014

A single vineyard Dolcetto Superior from a 12 acre parcel. Complex aromas of dark cherry, cloves and pepper. 54

324 Barbera d'Alba, Superiore, Bruna Grimaldi 2013

Undertones of cocoa and espresso with a classic finish and vein of texture. 42

338 Barbera d'Alba DOC, "Bussia," Giacosa Fratelli 2012

From the famed Bussia vineyard in Barolo, this choice is fruity with hints of fresh berries, spices and tobacco. 45

323 Barbera d'Alba Superiore, Brezza 2008/2011/2013

Fruit forward, cedar and spice. This deep and complex choice is perfect for Zinfandel and Syrah lovers. 48

346 Barbera d'Asti DOC, Superiore, Tenuta Olim Bauda Nizza 2012

Beautiful nose of dark cherries, licorice, tar and smoke. This medium to full-bodied wine is a great Barbera with high acidity and silky tannins. A very balanced selection with a long finish. Needs aeration. 58

319 Barbaresco DOCG, "Asij," Ceretto 2011

Ruby red color with orange reflections, this choice is penetrating, full and varied. The tannins are silky and fully developed. It is reminiscent of wild berries with a rich body and good texture. 85

320 Barbaresco Gallina DOCG, La Spinetta 2008

Ripe fruit aromas and flavors of blueberry and boysenberry are accented by flowers and Asian spices. 3 Glasses Gambero Rosso, 94 Suckling, Vinous: 94 and Wine Spectator: 92pts. 165

326 Barbaresco Serraboella DOCG, Cigliutti 2004

Intricately layered power and finesse. Violets and roses, earth, tar and tea held together with bright red fruits. 185

354 Gattinara DOCG, Travaglini 2010

100% Nebbiolo. Undertones of dried flowers and very ripe fruits. Big and chewy, yet smooth and complex with a rich finish. David recommends. 54

333 Barolo DOCG, Casa E di Mirafiore 2010/2011

Aromas of rose petals and dried cherries give way to flavors of plum, black cherry and spice with tightly grained tannins and a firm structure paving way for a long, complex finish. 66

317 Barolo Cabutto DOCG, Tenuta La Volta 2013

Classic, full-bodied Barolo with hints of tar and roses. 68

322 Barolo DOCG, Pertinace 2010

Lush and complex bouquet with hints of sweet spice, ripe fruit and vanilla. Great depth on the palate with dried fruit and herbs. A well-balanced, structured and smooth choice. 75

RED WINES: PIEDMONT, ITALY

331 Barolo Serralunga d'Alba DOCG,
Fontanafredda 2009/2011

An intense, clear-cut nose with overtones of vanilla, spice, roses and underbrush. Dry, but soft, velvety and full-bodied. Well-balanced and long-lasting on the palate. 79

334 Barolo Cannubi DOCG, Brezza
2010/2011

Classic Barolo from one of the best vintages in decades. Pretty, aromatic nose of flowers and spices followed by flavors of small red fruits and minerals. Fine and ripe tannins. 79

339 Barolo DOCG, "Brunate," Marcarini
2009/2011/2012

"Soft and supple. Full-bodied with ripe black cherries, chocolate liqueur and hints of citrus zest. A wine of substantial length and elegance." - Robert Parker. WA: 91pts, WE: 93pts. 88

321 Barolo, "Pressenda" DOCG, Marziano
Abbona 2010

From the Monforte d'Alba commune of Barolo. Intense and ethereal aromas of dried roses, tar and violets with notes of warm wood and spice. This full-body wine is comprised of sweet fruit with a long, caressing finish. Wine Spectator: 91pts. 104

330 Barolo, Serralunga d'Alba DOCG,
"Cascina Francia," Giacomo Conterno
1993

Dark ruby and purple nuances with roasted herbs, tobacco and dried cherries. Very mellow, yet round in the mouth. 370

RED WINES: TUSCANY

Although Chianti is the best known area in Tuscany and Sangiovese the most important grape, this region has far more to offer. Brunello (a superior clone of Sangiovese) is Tuscany's wine of greatest stature, producing wines of legendary power and longevity. The Cabernet Sauvignon or Merlot based wines aged in small French oak barrels, often called "Super Tuscans," give Tuscany another dimension with their powerful concentration and luxurious richness.

- 369 Chianti Classico DOCG, Petroio 2012**
Deep, earthy Sangiovese with fruity notes of black cherries and firm, food-friendly tannins. 42
- 376 Chianti Classico DOCG, Vignamaggio Estate 2012**
A beautiful, well-balanced and fruit forward choice from one of Tuscany's oldest wineries. Smooth with a silky finish. 39
- 370 Chianti Classico DOCG, Riserva, La Maialina 2008**
Inviting aromas of black cherries, plums and sweet spices with notes of roses and black pepper create an elegant and lush flavor. Ripe, round tannins and a long finish on the palate. Wine Spectator: 92pts. 48
- 372 Chianti Classico DOCG, Isole E Olena 2013**
Aromas of smoky black fruit and plum complement this medium-bodied wine with fine, delicate tannins. A nice, fruity finish and a twist of milk chocolate. 54
- 371 Chianti Classico Riserva DOCG, Casa Emma 2012**
Dried fruits, mushrooms and flowers dance around a core of classic Sangiovese cherry fruit. Wine Spectator: 92pts. 68
- 373 Chianti Classico DOCG, Riserva Marchesi Antinori Tenuta Tignanello 2013**
Made by the famous Antinori family from the 1500s and Tignanello is one of their top wines. 76
- 363 Rosso di Montepulciano DOC, Poliziano 2013**
80% Sangiovese, 20% Merlot. Known as the "baby brother" to Vine Nobile, one of Tuscany's most illustrious red wines, this choice has cherry, blackberry and velvety tannins. 38
- 378 Vino Nobile di Montepulciano DOCG, Corte alla Flora 2012**
Intense, clear and fragrant fruit aromas of raspberry with soft and velvety flavors followed by pleasant tannins across the palate. 48
- 361 Rosso di Montalcino DOC, Castello Banfi 2010**
Intense, fresh and fruity bouquet of aromatics with typical violet, cherry and plum undertones. Gentle, yet full on the palate with surprising length. 48
- 374 Rosso di Montalcino DOC, Il Poggione 2013**
Sweet cherries, raspberries and pomegranate create a fabulous value from one of the highest regarded Brunello producers. Vinous: 91pts. Wine Spectator: 90pts. 55
- 364 Rosso di Montalcino DOCG, Siro Pacenti 2011/2013**
A big wine with massive structure and rich, dark and firm tannins. Wine Spectator calls Giancarlo Pacenti, "the greatest winemaker in the appellation." 65

RED WINES: TUSCANY

357 Brunello di Montalcino DOCG, Caprili 2010

Expressive and focused aromas of red currants, black cherries and licorice. A finely balanced wine with an intensity of velvet on the palate and a lengthy, heavy finish. Wine Spectator: 94pts. 78

360 Brunello di Montalcino DOCG, Canalicchio 2008

Full-bodied with layers of fruit and raisins. A complex choice, yet very smooth for its youth. JS: 92pts, Wine Spectator: 90pts, WE: 90pts. 78

358 Brunello di Montalcino DOCG, La Fortuna 2011

Dark cherry and berry blends with notes of coffee, white pepper and wild herbs. 78

359 Brunello di Montalcino DOCG, Il Poggione 2007/2011

Roses, violets, raspberries, spices and mint all take form in this 2007 that impresses for its freshness and pure energy. Vinous & Tazner: 95pts, Wine Spectator: 92pts, WE: 91pts, and Suckling: 94pts. 125

375 Barco Reale di Carmignano DOC, Cappezzano 2012

Concentrated with sweet dense tannins and a lush velvety texture with ripe blackberry and dark cherry flavors mingling on the finish. JS: 91pts and Vinous: 90pts. 38

384 Fontalloro, Fattoria di Felsina 2012

100% Sangiovese, a Super-Tuscan. A fresh and chunky red that's well structured and balanced with hocolate and ripe cherry aromatics on the nose. A medium to full-bodied choice with soft, silky tannins and a long, clean fruit finish. David recommends. WE: 94pts and JS: 93pts. 95

386 Tignanello Toscana IGT, Piero Antionri 2012/2013

Piero Antinori's best, very limited in supply. Big, long and intense on the palate. A great representation of how Tuscan wine should be. JS: 96pts and WE: 95pts. 140

380 Bolgheri DOC Superiore, Ornellaia 2010/2011

Deep and intense wine with confit style cherry-pie fruit and a smoky character that's full on the palate. 265

Bright and fruity with a jammy nose. This delightful wine combines the elegance and suppleness of Merlot and Syrah with the austerity of Sangiovese. 74

336 Magari, Gaja, Ca’Marcanda, Tuscany 2011

Gaja’s first Bordeaux blend of Cabernet, Cabernet Franc and Merlot. Fruity, subtle texture with a full body. Young, yet very approachable. Wine Spectator: 90pts and Parker: 94pts. 115

304 Barbaresco DOCG, Gaja 2006

“A sensual nose in its complexity, with aromas of forest fruits, plums, licorice, mineral and coffee. Terrific concentration and silk-like tannins on a long complex finish. Parker, WA: 93pts, WE: 93pts, WS: 91pts and Tanzer: 90pts. 350

310 Barbaresco, Gaja Costa Russi, 1989

368 Sito Moresco Langhe DOC, Gaja 2013

308 Costa Russi Langhe DOC, Gaja 2006

Elegant Nebbiolo with 5% Barbera from the Costa Russi vineyard in Barbaresco. Wild berry with beautiful background renderings of smoke and graphite. WE: 95pts, WA: 92pts and Wine Spectator: 92pts. 450

RED WINES: CAMPANIA, ABRUZZO, UMBRIA, VENETO AND SICILY

Valpolicella is the name given to a blend of native grapes, of which Corvina Veronese is the key component, especially in Amarone and Recioto, since the drying process seems to bring out its best.

392 Valpolicella Classico Superiore DOC, Ripasso “Solane,” Santi 2012

Intense bouquet of cloves, vanilla, cherry jam and almonds. On the palate, the wine is full and warm with a harmonious, elegant finish. 40

390 Amarone della Valpolicella DOC, Righetti 2011

From a family run winery established in 1904, this Amarone shows a classic bouquet of dried fruit and almonds with a hint of anise. Extremely rich flavors with a long, smooth finish. 63

388 Amarone della Valpolicella DOC, Villa Arvedi, Bertani Valpantena 2011

Intense purple coloring with a deep nose and expressive flavors. Raisins, cherries and wild berries create a full-bodied, yet approachable house favorite. 88

389 Amarone della Valpolicella Classico DOC, Allegrini 2010

A true classic of the appellation with imposing structure and depth. Through its aromas of mature fruit and spices, this wine is sustained by the right degree of acidity and refined tannins on the palate. Bicchieri: 3, Decanter: 96pts, WA 93pts, WE: 92pts and Wine Spectator: 92pts. 115

393 Pallazzo dell Torre IGT, Veronese, Allegrini 2011

Rich, full-bodied with great concentration. A perfect compliment to our traditional Spaghetti alla Bolognese. 45

399 Montepulciano d’Abruzzo DOC, Quattro Mani 2013

Fresh and fruity with smooth flavors of currant, strawberry and raspberry. Attilio Pagli is one of the “four hands” in this project to showcase traditional wines, grown sustainably and bottled at the source. 35

PINOT NOIR: THE WILLAMETTE VALLEY

The Willamette Valley is recognized as one of the premier Pinot Noir producing regions in the world. Protected from the Pacific storms by the Coastal Range and from the dry, high heat of the desert by the Cascades, our valley boasts the ideal conditions for the picky, cool-climate Pinot.

This is our local wine and we have reason to be proud of it.

427 Pinot Noir, Stoller Family Estate, Dundee Hills, Willamette Valley 2014

Dark cherry and smoky flint play against subtle notes of raspberries, roses and hibiscus. 45

438 Pinot Noir, Stoller Family Estate, Reserve 2012

An integrated balance of dark cherry and raspberry, accented by spicy notes and a seamless finish. 70

428 Pinot Noir, Primarius, Willamette Valley 2014

Very light in color and Burgundian in style. This delicate Pinot has classic scents of rose petals and violets, leading into flavors of raspberry, marionberry, chocolate and spice. 39

434 Pinot Noir, Four Graces, Willamette Valley 2014

RED WINES: MERLOT AND CABERNET SAUVIGNON

For many, Cabernet Sauvignon is the king of wine grapes, and the Cabernets from certain vineyards in Napa, Sonoma and other areas of California are among the very best anywhere. In less than thirty years, California wineries making Cabernet Sauvignon have gone from candidates to authorities, so that even wine makers in Bordeaux are studying (and copying) the styles and methods of California Cabernet.

In Washington's Columbia, Yakima and Walla Walla appellations, these "Bordeaux Varieties" are world-class. With the intense hot days and cold nights of these regions, the wines develop great fruit and structure. More and more, Merlots and Cabernets from Washington's hot arid climate are also attaining this high quality.

527 Merlot, Jade Mountain, Napa Valley 2014

Deep in color and wonderfully balanced with layers of ripe dark fruits. 37

510 Merlot, Dry Creek Vineyards, Dry Creek Valley, Sonoma County 2009

Rich, well-structured and intense. 38

502 Merlot, Abacela, Umpqua Valley 2013

Wonderful aromas of black currants and spice. 42

507 Merlot, Ferrari Carano, Sonoma Valley 2013

A big, smoky fruitiness with a long finish on the palate. 45

580 Cabernet Sauvignon, Silver Oak, Alexander Valley 2012

Producing consistently excellent wine for over 30 years. 115

583 Cabernet Sauvignon, Joseph Phelps, Napa Valley 2012

Beautiful aromatics of plum, cherry, currants, coffee, cocoa and hints of allspice, fresh thyme, tobacco and forrest floor create an exotic, layered wine. The body is laced with integrated tannins, great freshness and red fruit characteristics. Galloni: 92pts. 100

554 Cabernet Sauvignon, Caymus, Napa Valley 2014

This well-balanced and highly inviting wine is almost universally ranked among the top Cabernets made in California. Consistently ripe, deep, supple and intense loaded with rich, creamy oak flavors. 130

596 Justin Isosceles, Paso Robles 2013

A classic Left Bank Bordeaux style wine comprised of Cabernet, Cabernet Franc and Merlot. Rich and aromatic with dark fruit, licorice, cinnamon, vanilla, tobacco and cocoa. Tanzer IWC: 91pts and WA: 92pts. 120

567 Cabernet Sauvignon, Leonetti, Walla Walla Valley 2013

Dark and powerful, yet generous with a nose of blackberries, spice, blue fruits and black tea with a hint of toasted French oak. WA: 96pts. 160

572 Cabernet Sauvignon, Beaulieu Vineyard, George de Latour Reserve, Napa Valley 2012

Aged in small oak barrels, this elegant wine has the structure to age and improve for decades as it exhibits complex flavors of black cherry and currants. 165

RED WINES: ZINFANDEL

Zinfandel is a black-skinned grape indigenous to Croatia that made its way to Italy where it is known as Primitivo. The plantings there are predominantly in the heel region of Apulia. Sometime in the mid 1800's the grape made its way into California where it has become a mainstay of California's wine identity. Zinfandel is stylistically very versatile with wines that range from bright and lively to deeply brooding and port-like, depending on the soils and climate where it is grown and the winemaker's intention. We bring you an interesting cross section of our southern neighbor's offerings.

750 Zinfandel, Rodney Strong "Knotty Vines," Alexander Valley 2013

Fresh bright berry fruit from the 105-year-old Russian River vines combine with the ripe peppery jamminess from the Alexander Valley vineyards for a wonderful diversity of flavor. 42

760 Zinfandel, Orin Swift Cellars "The Prisoner," Napa Valley 2013

A field blend, predominately of Zinfandel with other old vine mixes and black grapes. This choice was a two-time top 100 wine for Wine Spectator 2004 and 2005. 72

761 Zinfandel, Seghesio, Sonoma County 2013

Wild berry patch aromas and flavors of briary spiciness, cracked pepper, tilled soil and creamy oak with ever present acidity and fine, dusty tannins. Wine Spectator: 90pts, WA: 90pts. 44

762 Zinfandel, Turley "Juvenile," California 2014

A multiple vineyard blend creates a perfumed, light wine with great balance. Flavors of roses, sweet cherry and plum are layered with mint and cinnamon notes. 47

763 Zinfandel, Klinker Brick, Lodi, California 2012/2013

Aromatics of black raspberry, cedar shavings, pepper and spice with flavors of berries and dark cherry. This wine is medium-bodied with firm structure and a silky texture. 45

764 Zinfandel, Turley "Ueberroth," Paso Robles 2013

Planted in 1885 on limestone soil creates a big, ripe wine with great acidity. Flavors of black cherry and raspberry with hints of crushed rock. WA: 95pts, Wine Spectator: 94pts and Vinous: 94pts. 110

749 Zinfandel, Dashe Cellars, Dry Creek Valley, Sonoma County 2013

Concentrated and balanced with excellent ripeness and earthy, mineral flavors that highlight cherry currant and raspberry undertones. Finishes with flavors of cedar, vanilla and licorice lingering on the finish. 49

OTHER RED VARIETALS: PACIFIC NORTHWEST AND CALIFORNIA

718 Malbec, Abacela, Umpqua Valley 2013

Aromas of ripe, red cherries with plum, anise and black pepper compliment the flavors of hibiscus, sandalwood and cherry to create a long, lush finish. 46

720 Tempranillo, Abacela “Fiesta Blend,” Estate Grown, Umpqua Valley 2013

A big, dark wine with flavors of ripe brably and stone fruits with hints of leather and floral notes on the nose. Flavors of juicy blackberry, plum, vanilla, spice and licorice cover the palate. This medium to heavy-bodied choice has firm, round tannins and is a house favorite. 46

714 Syrah, Klinkerbrick Farrah, Lodi 2011

A classic, Left Bank Bordeaux style wine comprised of Cabernet, Cabernet Franc and Merlot. Rich and aromatic with dark fruit, licorice, cinnamon, vanilla, tobacco and cocoa. Tanzer IWC: 91pts and WA: 92pts. 45

722 Syrah, Gramercy Cellars “Lagniappe,” Columbia Valley, Washington 2013

Extremely complex with smoked meat notes around a core of intense red fruit, blueberry, minerals, black olive and pepper. WA: 95pts and Vinous 93pts. 92

716 Petite Sirah, Parducci “True Grit” Reserve Mendocino 2012/2013

Heady aromas of ripe fruit, white pepper and vanilla followed by an intense rush of fresh blackberry, dark chocolate, pepper and caramel flavors. 45

717 Petite Sirah, Earthquake Phillips, Lodi, California 2013

Dark red in color, this is a lush choice with fruity flavors of maraschino cherries and a great, long finish. 48

721 Petite Sirah, Girard, Napa Valley 2013

Aromatics of olive, anise, coffee, thyme and dark fruits unveil a rich palate with a mouthful of bittersweet chocolate, espresso, blackberry cobbler, dusty cinnamon and mocha. The finish evolves with bright acidity and inky tannins. WA: 93pts, WE: 92pts, Wine Spectator: 90pts. 55

RED WINES: IBERIA, SPAIN

Top quality, food friendly wines from the Iberian Peninsula have been recognized since at least the Roman era. Typically blended from indigenous grape varieties such as Tempranillo, Touriga, Grenache, Carignan and Graciano, these wines have a capacity to age long periods or to be enjoyed young.

In the 1980s, wine makers moved away from the traditional extended aging in old oak, toward a deeper, fruit-forward international style, using newer oak barrels and at times adding small amounts of Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon. We find these wines to be a natural companion to our style of regional cuisine.

812 Tempranillo, El Coto, Rioja, Crianza 2012

100% Tempranillo with layers of fresh raspberries, cherry, cedar and notes of vanilla and leather. This classically styled Rioja has a long, soft finish. 38

803 Tempranillo, Muga, Rioja Reserva, unfiltered 2012

Fruit sourcing from century-old valley-floor vineyards ensuring rich flavor extraction and a fruit-forward palate with wonderful layers of complexity from multiple soil types. Flavors of Kirsch, raspberry, red licorice and dark plums fill the mouth with subtle notes of tobacco, dried hay and cedar. WE: 90pts. 54

806 Tempranillo, Cruz de Alba Crianza, Ribera del Duero 2008/2013

100% Tempranillo with aromatics of ripe red and black berries mixed with notes of sweet spices and mint. Massive fruit flavors on the palate with hints of juicy red plums, smoke and minerals. WA: 90pts. 51

805 Tempranillo, Pesquera Crianza, Ribera del Duero 2012/2013

An intensely wild and gamy wine with perfumed musk and grilled meats layered atop cherry and black currant notes. Wine Spectator: 92pts and Vinous: 92pts. 65

809 Tempranillo, Rioja Grand Reserva, Faustino 2001/2004

A prime example of an aged Rioja. Powerful, yet elegant with a complex array of flavors. Delicate use of creamy oak and spicy, leathery notes combined with ripe bramble fruits and a mineral finish. D:97pts and WE: 91pts. 68

817 Garnacha, Vinas Viejas, Las Rocas, Calatayud, Spain 2012

The spicy, rich cranberry bouquet is followed by dark cherry flavors providing an excellent structure and elegant oak. Round and full in the mouth with supple tannins and a fruit-filled finish. Wine Spectator: 90pts. 42

816 Garnacha, Bodegas Alto Moncayo, Campo de Borja 2013

Sweet perfume of blackberries and toasty oak with an opulent, fleshy and fruity palate. This choice has plenty of muscle and potency with a long, silky finish. Al King recommends. Vinous: 93pts and Wine Spectator: 91pts. 75

VINTAGE PORTS

Port has changed very little since its origins in the 1800s. The grapes are picked, crushed and fermented quickly. After about two days the must is fortified with neutral spirit, which arrests the fermentation and leaves some sweetness. While other kinds of Port are aged for many years, vintage Port is bottled unfiltered after only two years.
