DR. DALE LYNCH JOINS TOSS TEAM

New Executive Director Named

NASHVILLE –The Tennessee Organization of School Superintendents released the following statement announcing the selection of Dr. Dale Lynch as the new Executive Director:

At the Tennessee Organization of School Superintendents (TOSS) Legislative & Learning Conference in February, Executive Director Wayne Miller, announced his retirement. In the months following, the TOSS Board of Directors conducted a search and interview process. On May 8, 2017 the board selected Dr. Dale Lynch to take on this role leading 142 school superintendents in the advancement of public education in Tennessee.

Dr. Lynch has nearly 25 years of professional experience as an education administrator, along with his Masters and Doctorate degrees in education. He has spent the last sixteen years serving as the superintendent of Hamblen County Schools. Dr. Lynch has served as an officer on the TOSS Board for many years. In 2014, he received the Tennessee Superintendent of the Year Award. He has also received other accolades including the TSBA Award for Excellence, National School Boards Association “20 To Watch” Educational Leaders, the State Collaborative on Reforming Education District of the Year, and many more.

Current Executive Director, Wayne Miller, stated “I am confident in Dr. Lynch’s ability to lead the continued growth of our organization, and serve superintendents across the state with distinction.”

Dr. Lynch’s retirement from Hamblen County Schools will take effect at the end of June, and he will then assume his position at TOSS.
