Meritan provides services for seniors, specialized foster care for children, skilled health care programs and services for the developmentally and intellectually disabled. Meritan has served Mid-South for over 50 years and is nationally accredited.

### Noteworthy Events/Accomplishments:

- Deborah Cotney, President of Meritan for over 30 years, retired in January of 2013.
- Meritan began providing Medical Residential Services through the TN Department of Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities (DIDD).
- Meritan received a grant from the Assisi Foundation to construct a Medical Residential Home in honor of the former president – the Deborah Cotney Cottage.
- Only 1 child out of 138 children served in the state of MS experienced more than 2 formal moves during the year.
- Tennessee Foster Care began services November 1, 2013.
- Georgia Foster Care served a total of 237 children statewide this year.
- Meritan's homemaker program began providing services to CHOICES and VA clients.
- Title V Senior Employment Program had a 93.6% customer satisfaction rating among host agencies and met 100% of funder goals for the year.
- Meritan Home Health was named a Top Agency of the 2013 HomeCare Elite™, a recognition of the top-performing home health agencies in the United States.
- Meritan was named to the Commercial Appeal 2013 Top Workplaces in Memphis.
- Meritan's East and West TN DIDD programs achieved 3 Star Quality Status.
- Meritan was reaccredited by the Council on Accreditation through 2017.
- Meritan served over 4,000 people in 2013.
