

Objective	Be the first person to get rid of all your cards.
Setup	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - This game works best with 4 players. - Using a standard 52-card deck, deal each player 13 cards.
Card rankings	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Cards ranked from highest to lowest: 2 A K Q J 10 9 8 7 6 5 4 3. - Suits ranked from highest to lowest: Hearts ♥ Diamonds ♦ Clubs ♣ Spades ♠. - Card rank takes precedence over suit rank, so the 8 ♣ is higher than the 7 ♦.
Gameplay	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The person with the 3 ♠ starts the game. If it isn't the first game, the winner of the previous game starts play. - Each player must beat the card(s) played on the previous turn. - Play continues until no one can beat a combination. - The person who played that combination gets to clear the table and start a new round.
Combinations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - <i>Single</i>: One card. The smallest single is a 3 ♠, and the highest is a 2 ♥. - <i>Pair</i>: Two cards with the same rank. Example: 6 ♥ 6 ♠. - <i>Triple</i>: Three cards with the same rank. Example: 8 ♣ 8 ♥ 8 ♠. - <i>Run</i>: Three or more cards of consecutive ranks. Example: 10 ♥ J ♣ K ♦. - <i>Bomb</i>: Either a combination of three pairs in sequence and of the same color or four of a kind. Examples: 4♥ 4♦ 5♥ 5♦ 6♥ 6♦ or 3♥ 3♦ 3♣ 3♠. - The only thing that can beat a combination is a higher combination of the same type and number of cards.
Special rules	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - If you don't have any playable combinations, you can pass; however, you will be locked out of play until someone wins the round. - A run or sequence can only be beaten by another sequence. In this case, the suits don't matter; just look at the highest card in each sequence.
Winning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The first person to run out of cards wins. - There are also a few ways to instantly win the game: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Having all four 2s: 2 ♥ 2 ♦ 2 ♣ 2 ♠ • Having six pairs in sequence: 3 ♥ 3 ♠ 4 ♠ 4 ♦ 5 ♣ 5 ♦ 6 ♠ 6 ♥ 7 ♣ 7 ♦ 8 ♥ 8 ♣ • Having three triples in sequence: 5 ♥ 5 ♠ 5 ♦ 6 ♦ 6 ♥ 6 ♣ 7 ♠ 7 ♦ 7 ♣ • Having a dragon, or all individual cards in sequence: 3 ♥ 4 ♥ 5 ♥ 6 ♥ 7 ♥ 8 ♥ 9 ♥ 10 ♥ J ♥ Q ♥ K ♥ A ♥ 2 ♥
