

# Gear Care Guide

**ALWAYS** refer to the manufacturer's guide for gear care and function. This is particularly important for computers. **ALWAYS** read your manuals.

**ALWAYS** fresh water rinse after **EVERY** dive. Ensure that your first stage internally stays dry and your BCD bladder is flushed. Pro valves on your cylinder are susceptible to corrosion. So, remove the plug when it is rinsed.

Store gear in a dry, climate controlled space, the cleaner the better. Leave your gear hanging. Ensure that hoses are not pinched and the BCD is left with a little air in the bladder.

Ensure that your gear is registered with the manufacturer at purchase. Some offer free parts for the life of the product and warranties when this is done.

Know your gear's service interval. Most manufacturers require an inspection every year and a full service every two years. Warranties and parts programs are voided if the gear is not maintained by a brand-specific certified service professional.

Hold on to all of your gear's receipts and service records! It makes warranty service quick and easy.
