The following are the costs for attending Florida College of Integrative Medicine in the first semester:

#### Application Fee:

Domestic Students **\$50** (non-refundable); Transfer Students **\$100** (non-refundable and includes Transcript Assessment Fee); International Students **\$300.00** (non refundable and includes Transcript Assessment Fee and documentation fee)

Registration Fee: **\$150.00 (Non-refundable and due at Registration)**

Tuition Down Payment: **\$250.00 of the \$8,635. (Full Tuition Amount)**

Technology Fee Per Semester: **\$100.00**

Student ID Card **\$10.00**

Parking Decal **\$10.00**

Tuition Per Semester: **\$8,635.**

**I understand that I will have to pay the following prior to class starting at Registration time**

**\$150.00 + \$250.00 + \$100.00 + \$10.00 + \$10.00 = \$520.00 Initial \_\_\_\_\_**

#### Remaining Tuition:

**\$8,385.** - Due from Federal Direct Loan disbursement 30 days after start of semester and if federal loan does not cover total remaining tuition a cash payment for the balance is due February 1<sup>st</sup>. If making cash payments for tuition the 1<sup>st</sup> monthly payment of \$1,477. is due February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017. Remaining payments of \$1,727. are due on the 1<sup>st</sup> of every month through June.

#### Books:

The cost of **1<sup>st</sup> semester books is approximately \$476.06, if purchased at FCIM.** The cost for six semesters is approximately \$2,451.04. Many of the books purchased for the first semester will be used throughout the whole program.

The Bookstore is located in our library at the main building. A list of courses and the books for each semester is available in the bookstore and on our website. All required books are available for purchase from FCIM's Bookstore but may also be purchased elsewhere i.e. bookstores, on-line, etc.

#### Courses:

Clean Needle Technique Course: You will need to spend **up to \$50.00** for supplies.

Point Location I Course: You will need to spend **up to \$10.00** for supplies.

**CNT National Exam:**

Clean Needle Technique National Exam: This is a national exam that is offered at the end of your Clean Needle Technique Course in first semester; however, the monies for it are due within about a month from class start. **The cost is \$150.00** and is paid directly to the exam sponsor.

**Clinic:**

For Clinic Internship, you will need clinic attire to be determined by Clinic Director.–This attire runs \$55.00 and up for scrubs and an FCIM emblem for first semester. (The approximate cost for clinic attire for the program is \$300.)

**Technology:**

A Technology Fee of **\$100** is assessed to the student every semester for examination and evaluation services.
