



## WA FEST RULES & FAQ

### RULES

- WA FEST is a rain or shine event.
- All ticket holders are subject to search upon entry. Wristbands must be worn at all times.
- Bring your ID to drink(Must be 21). NO DRUGS ALLOWED.
- NO WEAPONS.
- No pets.

#### *YOU MAY BRING*

Phone, sunscreen, small purses or backpacks (bags must be 12in x 12in or smaller), blankets, camp chairs, any camping supplies.

#### *LEAVE IN YOUR CAR OR AT HOME*

Fireworks, explosives of any kind, weapons, bladder style backpacks, bota bags, firearms or weapons of any kind, drugs, drug paraphernalia, outside alcohol, audio recording devices, pets and animals.

#### *AGE RESTRICTIONS*

Kids are welcome but must have a ticket. Children 7 and under are admitted free but must be accompanied by an adult.

#### *DRUG & ALCOHOL POLICY*

You must be 21 to drink and you must possess a valid ID to purchase alcohol. WA FEST is a zero tolerance event. All local and State laws will be strictly enforced. There will be no tolerance for illegal activities. We will have security guards on premise working with local law enforcement.

### Info & FAQ

#### *Food & Alcohol*

We will have beer and wine for sale(Virginia Mountain Vineyards, PBR, Pkwy Brewery, Ballast Point) and there will be multiple food vendors(BBQ, tacos, burritos). No outside alcohol is allowed on premise. Please bring your own reusable pint(NO GLASS). We have compostable cups for alcohol sales, but please help us cut down on trash. Outside food is allowed in the camping areas. Outside food is not allowed in the music field.

#### *Pets*

Normally we love having guest's dogs, but due to the size of this event, NO PETS are allowed at WA FEST.

#### *What are we permitted to bring into the concert site?*

Blankets and low back chairs are permitted. No food or outside alcohol is allowed to be brought into the Concert Site. Small umbrellas are okay but NO pop-up-tents or shade structures allowed. There is a covered pavilion close to stage.

### *What are the different camping options?*

*Community Tent Camping:* allows you to camp with your car parked in a nearby lot. You can easily camp with your friends and have access to your car via a short walk. Your car will be parked a few hundred yards away. The community camping area is close to the music field and our main lodge. One wristband is required per person.

*Family Camping:* allows camping further from the hubub and noise of the main festival area. This is set in the wooded/shaded area of our property in smaller primitive sites. There is limited availability for this area though we will fit as many we as can comfortably. You will have to transport any equipment on foot, though as the jeep trail they are located near is too narrow for traffic.

*RV Camping:* RV Camping – Your RV must fit into a 20' X 50' space (including slides or awnings). Tents, canopies, hammocks, etc. may be set up next to your RV as long as they fit within the designated space. It is a primitive RV site so no dumping stations. Please arrive at the festival with a full water tank and bring a portable container. Water will be available. Power is limited and connection are on a first come first serve basis.

### *Answers to Fire-related questions*

- No tiki torches
- No campfires at the community camping area. WA FEST will provide fire pits.

### *Will there be water in the campgrounds?*

Refillable water bottles are encouraged. There are multiple free water spigots on our basecamp. Please only drink from potable(BLUE) spigots.

### *Can we bring water to the music field?*

Refillable water bottles are encouraged. There are multiple free water spigots on our basecamp. Please only drink from potable(BLUE) spigots.

### *Will there be showers in the campgrounds?*

Yes! We are limited to 4 male and 4 female shower stalls.

### *Will we be able to exit the concert area and return to the campgrounds throughout the day?*

Yes, guests can come and go from campgrounds to concert site as often as they wish as long as they hold an event wristband and do not enter with any outside food or beverage.

### *Will there be Cell Service?*

Yes, but very limited. Verizon works the best and is strongest by our office.

### *Will there be an ATM on site?*

Guests can get cash at our camp store(in our office) for a 5% fee.

### *What Activities are available?*

We have miles of trails for unguided hiking and biking. Canoes are available to take out on our pond. Anyone in the pond must have a PFD(lifejacket). Canoes are limited, so please do not use for more than an hour at a time. Bikes will be available to rent on a first come basis. Climbing Wall, Zip Line, and Canoe rentals(require passes) are available throughout the festival on a first come basis. All activities requiring passes can be purchased at our office and will leave 15 minutes before the hour.

### *EMS & Security?*

EMS & Security will be around throughout the entire event. EMS will be stationed on the back porch of our lodge next to the beer ticket sales. Security will be patrolling the parking, camping, and music area. Coolers/bags are subject to search.

*Arrival & Departure?*

Guests are welcome to arrive as early as 4:30 PM Friday. 10 AM Sunday, we will lead a hike to our scenic Bluff Overlook. This will be the closing of WA Fest and will be our goodbye for anyone not on the final 11 AM activities.
