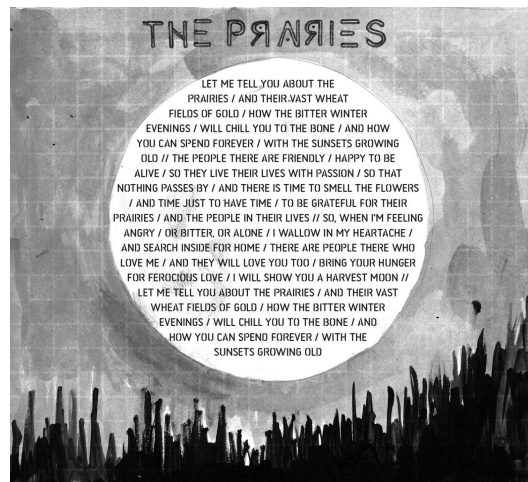


**TARA WILLIAMSON PRESENTS:**
