This certificate program consists of a 5 month seminar series focusing on clinical supervision and management skills for child welfare supervisors at Local Departments of Social Services. Participants will apply seminar learning to current employment responsibilities, and receive coaching to enhance successful implementation.

Who: Child welfare supervisors in Maryland's Local Departments of Social Services, who have been in their current role for 5 years or less. **Participants' immediate supervisor must also simultaneously attend the Supervision Matters Administrators series. Online registration required .*
