### **CIVIC CENTER POOL AREAS**

- 3-lane 20 yard, instructional/exercise/lap pool
- Leisure pool w/ 4-lane 25 yard lap pool
- Warm water spa

### **FEATURES**

- Lazy river w/ inner tubes
- 94 foot long water/loop slide that starts from 14 feet in the air
- One meter diving board
- Three in-water play features
- Water vortex
- Easy access beach entry with shallow water play area and tot slide
- Tot pool separated from pool by a whale wall with a bench
- Bubbler bench
- Indoor water spray ground with Jolly Roger tumble buckets, water cannons, and spray bars
- Viewing area from multi-purpose room
- Men's, Women's, and 2 Family Locker Rooms
  - Suit-mate for drying swim suits

## ROCKY RIVER INDOOR POOL RULES

- Do not swim in closed areas.
- Parents -- please watch your children.
- Children 7 years & younger must be accompanied by a responsible person age 15 years or older.
- Weak or non-swimmers are to remain in shallow, shoulder height water.
- Diving is only permitted from the diving board or the side wall where the diving board is located.
- Walk – no running.
- Sprayground area – age appropriate. Kiddie Area – 6 & under
- Do not climb on whale wall.
- Approved toys allowed in the wading pool only. Water noodles permitted in the main pool during selected times as posted. Balls of any type are prohibited.
- Enter the lazy river from the stairs or activity pool only.
- Proper swim attire is required.
- Phone usage NOT permitted in locker rooms. Use of cameras requires management approval.
- Food and drink permitted in multi-purpose room ONLY. Water in a plastic bottle is the only acceptable drink allowed on the pool deck. No food or gum is allowed on the pool deck.
- Anyone under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be refused entry or removed from the premises.
- Horseplay (shoving, dunking, etc.) and profanity are not permitted.
- Persons with infectious diseases, open sores, or recently with diarrhea are not permitted in the activity pool, sprayground, instructional pool, or spa.
- Failure to obey rules or instructions may be cause for removal.
- At the discretion of the Lifeguard, any swimmer may be asked to demonstrate their swimming ability to determine if they are able to use designated areas of the pools.
- Lifeguards are responsible for enforcing any additional rules that, in their judgment, will help maintain a safe pool for your use and pleasure.
- Other rules as posted at pool.

**Swim Diapers:** required for diaper-age children. Huggies or Little Swimmers are recommended.

**Flotation Devices:** In addition to Coast Guard-approved life jackets (available in guard office), the following flotation devices are permitted at the discretion of pool administration:

- Swim suit or jackets with flotation devices that do not rely on inflation
- A parent (adult 18 & over) is required to be in the water and with the child using a flotation device – ratio: one adult per child.
