This includes the use of an automated external defibrillator (AED) to care for a victim experiencing cardiac arrest.

To successfully complete the course, you must attend the entire course, participate and demonstrate competency in all required skills and scenarios, and pass the final written exam with a minimum grade of 80 percent.
