Cleator Annual Pilgrimage

The Annual Pilgrimage to the Diocesan shrine of Our Lady of Lourdes at Cleator will be on Sunday 10th September 2017 at 3.00 p.m. The principal celebrant and preacher will be Bishop Michael Campbell. We are told we live in a 'post-truth' society. Trust in politicians and the media is greatly undermined. As we honour Our Lady, Seat of Wisdom - we see her offering us her Son – the source of a more profound truth than this world can offer. As well as having a beautiful replica of the Lourdes grotto, we also have in the grounds of the shrine at Cleator statues of the Cure of Ars and of St Therese of Lisieux. The pilgrimage will be an opportunity not only to honour Mary the Mother of God, but also these two great saints, and to ask their intercession for healing and consolation.

As usual we invite the young people of our Diocese to walk in pilgrimage from Honister across Haystacks into Ennerdale then on to Cleator. They will begin their journey at Castlerigg Manor on Friday 8th September. The event is a great opportunity to make new friends and to triumph over a physical challenge.
