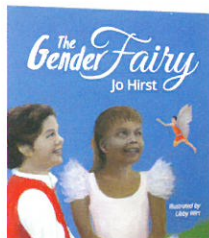


## SAFE SCHOOLS?

The *Safe Schools Program* was launched in schools in Victoria more than six years ago and has been rolled out across Australia.

It demands that all students not only accept but celebrate LGBTI lifestyles, and learn about intimate aspects of alternative sexualities.

It discriminates against teachers and children who have a different opinion due to their cultural heritage or beliefs.

**The program takes a whole-of-school approach – parents cannot opt-out.**

**The program overrides their parental right to shape their child's moral values.**

More effective and inclusive anti-bullying programs by Australian researchers promote respect for all people irrespective of their gender and sexuality.
