May 10 (Semi-Annual General Meeting)

- Pastor Ongerth' statistics; membership increased by 8 people, Sunday School problematic, many parents send their children to English Sunday School, bad for German in Montreal.
- Salvation Army offered \$ 6,000 for church property; was deemed not acceptable, asking price now \$ 8,000.

October 21

- Canada Synod reimbursed \$ 146.90 to the church.

November 8 (Semi-Annual Meeting)

- Pastor Ongerth: Sunday School shrinking; teachers missing
- no acceptable offer for sale yet
- treasurer's report: deficit \$ 260; will be greatly reduced if all pew fees have been paid by congregation.
