### 1902

#### January 21 (Annual General Meeting)

- New wording of §3 of the constitution was approved.
- Pew rental fees need to be collected. The Ladies' Aid was thanked for their support.

#### March 10

- The roof is still leaking and needs to be repaired before the interior of the church can be painted.

#### Notice: March 15

- Pastor Riedel is in the Royal Victoria Hospital again.

#### June 8

- The church will be closed for July and August.
- Books of the German Literary Society will be stored in the church.
- Pastor Riedel is sick once again and Pastor Trebitsch has volunteered to fill in.

#### October 11

- Pastor Riedel has been authorised to order coal whenever necessary, look for a new sexton (with the help of a committee), to spend \$5 for the Reformation Day celebration.
