Seeking Food Bank Coordinator

Looking for a way to get more involved in serving the community? The Food Bank needs you! After 4 years working in this wonderful ministry, Angela will be stepping down by the end of this year. She'd love to find someone new sooner, to ease them into the role. This is a very easy ministry to coordinate, thanks to these key features:

- monthly time commitment is minimal
- a fantastic team of volunteers to support the new coordinator, if needed
- very flexible: reorganize to fit your own strengths, interests, and schedule
- will train the new coordinator and remain involved as support, if needed.

The only requirement is that you distribute food. You can give the Food Bank as much or as little time as

you have. Angela currently spends around 12-14 hours a month, and spends most of it facilitating volunteers, rather than doing things directly herself. However, you need not keep her format. It can be as minimal as sitting in the office alone, handing out pre-made bags of food to who ever knocks on the door (how it was when Angela took it on). Or, you can also build on the community model that she has fostered, growing the Food Bank as a beloved hub of the neighbourhood.

As long as you share a passion for serving those in need, you can do this ministry. Forward the message to who ever may be interested.

Translations prepared in 2000 by Gisele Steine. Interesting extracts selected by Katherine Hedrich are featured below

1908

January 21 (Annual General Meeting)

- The Jeanne Mance lot has been bought for a cost of \$8,000 and will be paid as follows:
 - \$1,000 down payment
 - \$7,000 mortgage at 5% until January 1913
- A building committee has been formed and will issue monthly reports.

February 7 (1st Building Committee Meeting)

- Architect Rodden to submit plans.

February 14 (2nd Building Committee Meeting)

- Changes made to architectural plans.
- Estimates for building with either brick or concrete blocks were requested.

March 2 (3rd Building Committee Meeting)

- The entire lot will be used for the church and manse.

March 4 & April 4

(4th and 5th Building Committee Meetings)

- Approval of plans. Water heating system will be installed instead of air heating system.

April 20 & 27

(6th and 7th Building Committee Meetings)

- Options finalized. Final cost will be \$22,000 for the buildings. Construction to be completed by September 15, 1908.

October 20 (8th Building Committee Meeting)

- Construction details - fire insurance is necessary.
- A tasteful design of altar windows commissioned.

Inauguration of the New Church took place on Sunday, November 15, 1908.
