



FOH Sound Equipment Advance for bands

The Cloverdale Arts Alliance has an installed front of house sound system with two floor wedges for artists performing at the CAA Gallery. You will find the following equipment for your use:

2-two QSC K-10 speakers mounted on the ceiling for FOH mains

2-two QSC K-10 floor wedges for monitors with signal cable

1-rack mounted wireless ew100 Sennheiser microphone and receiver.

1-Soundcraft Signature Series 12 channel analog mixer. The mixer has eight XLR inputs with optional stereo inputs for devices. The mixing console comes with 3 auxiliary send channels. The room is very live so FOH reverb is not recommended.

There are no mic stands, microphones or cables provided other than those that serve the FOH mains, floor wedges and wireless microphone. The mixing console is stored in a small rolling rack fuzzy box and it is recommended that the console be placed on top of the rolling rack for operation.
