KENT, OH, October 3, 2017 - The Kent State University Undergraduate Student Government is announcing an opening for the Senator of Aeronautics and Engineering. The Senator is responsible for serving as a liaison between the students of the College of Aeronautics and Engineering and the USG. The main duties of a Senator is to formulate a hold weekly office hours, formulate a bi-weekly report, and to attend and participate in all activities of the USG including training workshops and seminars.

The Senator for the College of Aeronautics and Engineering must have declared a major within the College of Technology or be a pre-major for at least one semester prior to elections. If senator changes colleges, he or she must resign from his or her seat (3342-2-08 Undergraduate Student Government Charter (B) (5)). The senator must be in compliance and understanding with the bylaws of the Government, Robert's Rules of Order, and adhere to all USG rules, regulations, policies, and procedures.
