JUNIOR

fall

- Get the best grades in the toughest classes

winter

- Prep for the SAT or ACT
- Prep for your AP test(s)
- Research and apply for rad summer programs and jobs (related to your major = bonus)

Spring

- Take SAT or ACT for the first time
- Rock your AP Test(s)
- Finalize rad summer program or job
- Research schools and start developing your college list

summer

- Visit 2-3 colleges
- Attend summer program (or) Work summer job (or) Both
- Begin your personal statement

SENIOR

September

- Attend college fairs
- Take the SAT or ACT for second time
- Request your recommendation letters
- Decide if you'll apply Early Action or Early Decision

October

- Finalize your college list
- Finish your personal statement
- Start your supplemental essays
- Submit your Early Action or Early Decision application (if applicable)
- Submit your FAFSA: Oct 1 (earlier = better)

November & December

- Finish your personal statement and supplemental essays
- Last chance to take the SAT or ACT
- **Arts and Theater students:**
 - Finalize portfolios, audition tapes, writing samples
- Send official test scores to colleges
- Finalize and submit all your applications
