Getting ready to start the busy season for the choir! Auditions for both the madrigal dinner and spring musical went very well. Thanks to Mrs Giesler and Mrs SELEP for helping to measure for costumes this year.

This Friday Mads travels to ISU for the Madrigal festival. We leave RHS at 7:15 and will return around 4.

I mean jazz festival is this Saturday where we have a vocal jazz student for the first time in a while. Chris Bavaro travels to Hampshire High to perform with Vocal Jazz II

Next week is the Valley View Choral Festival at RHS. We are still looking for about three chaperones. 7:30-1:30 or so. Mixed choir is joining the festival for the first time this year.

On November 19 we have about 17 students performing at ILMEA district 9 festival for choir. We have not received a lot of information specific to this year, but students should plan to arrive to lake park high school west campus around 7:30am. They should bring music, water bottle, pencil and a choir robe. Usually kids wear something nicer under the robes, it probably makes most sense for them to wear that all day so there's less to misplace. I would suggest trying to wear something more on the comfortable side though. The 9-10 concert starts at noon and the 10-12 concert starts at 3.
