How to Apply for a Handgun Qualification License

As of October 1, 2013, the process of purchasing a regulated firearm in the state of Maryland has changed. Purchasers must possess a valid **Handgun Qualification License (HQL)**, or qualify for an exemption.

Step-by-Step Instructions

- 1. Go to https://emdsp.mdsp.org/egov/Login.aspx.
- If you have not done so already, create an account.
- 3. Log in using your new account.
- 4. Select the 'Initial Application' link in the middle of the page.
- 5. Select 'Firearms Services' as the Program.
- 6. Under License Type, select the appropriate dropdown:
 - a. HQL Permit Exempt This option requires you to have a valid handgun carry permit issued by the state of Maryland.
 - b. HQL Standard This option is for everyone who has not purchased a regulated firearm prior to October 1, 2013, AND requires you to complete a 4 hour training course. (If this is you, you can sign up for an upcoming training course at FreeState if you have not done so already.)
 - c. HQL Training Exempt This option is for everyone who has purchased a regulated firearm prior to October 1, 2013.
- 7. Select 'Application' as the Application Method.
- 8. Select 'Start Application' and proceed through each page until you complete the application. The final screen will allow you to 'Finish' the application, review your information and submit payment for the license.
