Cost: \$10 per registered participant (Covers awards and food)



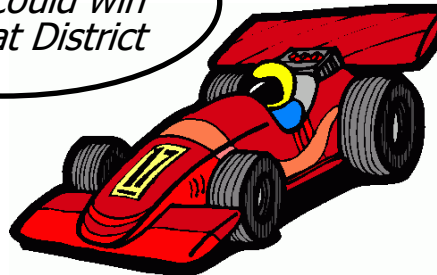
Cars without the high tech edge can still place and win. Awards given for normal rule set and classic car rule set
