Parent(s)/Guardian(s) of 330 Squadron Cadets,

As the month of November approaches, I would like to bring to your attention a few important activities related to Remembrance Day that our squadron will partake in. As members of the Canadian Cadet Organization (CCO), cadets are expected to participate in these mandatory activities and help show their support for the numerous men and women who made the ultimate sacrifice on our behalf in times of war and armed conflict; so that we can enjoy life in peace and freedom. As Air Cadets, our squadron members are also expected to actively participate in community service activities, such as assisting our veterans through poppy drives and remembering our fallen comrades through participating in military parades. Your support in ensuring maximum attendance at these activities will be truly appreciated.

1. **Poppy Drive – RCL Branch 10 – 1 & 8 November 2014:** All cadets are expected to participate in this mandatory activity. Cadets will be assisting legion members in collecting donations that will directly benefit veterans and their dependents. Cadets are expected to participate in one or both of the following shifts, 9am-3pm on 1 Nov 14 and/or 8 Nov 14. Sign-ups will occur on Wednesday. Community service hours will be granted following the event. Lunch will be provided to cadets **following** their shift. Cadets are permitted to bring a bagged lunch to consume while on location should they wish. Cadets must attend in their full uniform (or black and white attire for those without a uniform) with a parka and gloves. **Assistance from parent drivers will be required.** Cadets are to meet directly at Branch 10 of the Royal Canadian Legion.
2. **Remembrance Day Memorial Service – Royal Canadian Legion (RCL) Branch 10 – 9 November 2014, 7pm:** Parents and cadets are invited to join our veterans at branch 10's annual memorial service honouring those who sacrificed their lives for our freedom. Cadets are expected to attend in full uniform or black and white attire (for those without a uniform) while adjourning a poppy. All other guests are expected to wear business attire. Refreshments will follow the service. Branch 10 is located at 1083 Pape Ave. Toronto.

3. **Remembrance Day Parade – East York Civic Centre – 11 November 2014 – 9:45am:** This parade is mandatory for ALL cadets in the squadron. Cadets will be meeting at East York Collegiate Institute at 650 Cosburn Ave. Toronto for 9:45am.

The parade consisting of veterans and legion members, military members, cadet units, and other organizations, will march towards East York Civic Centre for a memorial service where the parade will conclude shortly after 11am. Cadets must attend in full uniform (or black and white attire for those without a uniform) while adorning a poppy. Jackets and gloves should be worn. As this parade is held during school hours, a school excusal letter will be provided to all cadets.

Together, with your support, we can ensure full attendance at all of the aforementioned activities and ensure that those who sacrificed their lives for our freedom are presented with the respect and honour they deserve by all members of 330 squadron.
