

Marsh Haven Nature Center is an all-volunteer, non-profit nature center featuring wall murals painted by wildlife artist Andy Stoffel of Cambellsport, WI. These murals depict the history and wildlife of the Horicon Marsh area. A diverse collection of wildlife art and photography is also on display and for sale. Wildlife rehabilitator Barbara Harvey presents an educational program on Wild Birds of Prey every Saturday afternoon in October at 1 pm. Located at the northwest corner of the Horicon Marsh, just 3 miles east of Waupun on Hwy 49. Please note: Saturday special event admission is \$3 for adults and \$2 for children; Sunday admission is \$2 for adults and \$1 for children. Admission includes hiking trails, program, museum displays and art gallery.
