**Detroit XPAC Congratulates Gary Peters and Stephanie Chang**

Detroit XPAC congratulates Representative Gary Peters (D-14) and Stephanie Chang (D) for winning their elections on November 4. Gary Peters will become the next Senator from the State of Michigan and Stephanie Chang will become the next Representative from District 6 to serve in the Michigan House of Representatives. Chang also makes history by becoming the first female Asian American to serve in Michigan's legislature. Detroit XPAC endorsed Peters and Chang earlier this year.

“Senator-elect Peters and Representative-elect Chang made a tremendous impression on members of our organization,” said Detroit XPAC co-founder Julia Farber. “We know they will fight for Detroit and provide a vision for ways the city can grow and prosper in the future. We celebrate their success and look forward to working with them and other candidates in the years ahead.”

The PAC endorsed Senator-elect Peters primarily because of his commitment to provide access to capital for small businesses and fast-growing startups in Michigan, and to expand public transportation options throughout Michigan's southeast region. He supports legislation that creates a thriving business hub in Detroit and makes investments in next-generation manufacturing and infrastructure. He also has worked to protect the Great Lakes, and to support mechanisms that lead to affordable housing and sustainable communities.

Detroit XPAC backed Stephanie Chang because she is committed to the most vulnerable residents in her district. She wants to establish a neighborhood service center for Detroit residents in her district and create coalitions of communities that can work together for future development. She also hopes to focus on building more public transportation options for residents and low-income housing choices, and will fight for environmental justice.

Founded in 2013, Detroit XPAC is helping to elect officials in the City of Detroit and the state of Michigan who will promote the interests of the City of Detroit and Michigan's citizens.
