Be a SELLER-

Bring your formal wear items: clean, on hangers and priced to sell to the meeting on the 14th. Arrive by 6:00 p.m. to set up.

It is preferred that sellers be present, but if that isn't possible, please contact Leslie Hertz (lfox3@wi.rr.com) to arrange an earlier drop off. If you will not be present to sell your items, a Parents' Assoc. rep will contact you after the sale regarding any remaining items and/or payment for sold items.

Price tags must contain sellers name and the item price.

Also include a card with your contact information: Name, email, phone. Please indicate if price is firm or if you have a minimum price (per item and specify item).

Be a BUYER-

Bring your son(s) or daughter(s) to the Parents' Association meeting on Wednesday, September 14th at 7-8 p.m. to shop the selection of formal wear.

Items will be available beginning at 7:00 p.m. in the Lower Library – there are no reserves

Items will be clearly marked with the price and some prices may be negotiable.

Cash or Check only – checks need to be made out to the seller (not St. Catherine's). All sales are final.

Any questions about specific formal wear items need to be addressed with the seller.
