



PATRICIUS WINERY TOKAJ, HUNGARY

- Awarded “Best Hungarian Winery” September 2013. Vineyards established by royal decree in 1737, all deemed 1st Growth Vineyards.
- Currently producing wine from 85 hectares. 120+ hectares of contiguous vineyards in total.
- Only estate producing all three single DRY varietals: Furmint, Harslevelu, and Yellow Muscat.
- Owned by the Kékessy Family, descendants of famed Hungarian nobility.
- Patricius in Latin means ‘Nobleman’. Family patriarch is a Hungarian Ambassador, close friends with the Prime Minister.
- First full production was in 2000. First brought to market in Hungary in 2006.
