

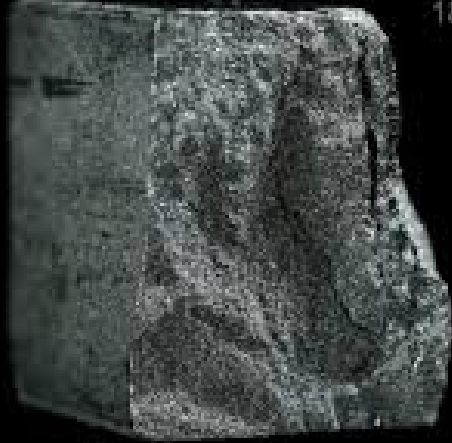
Conflict Minerals

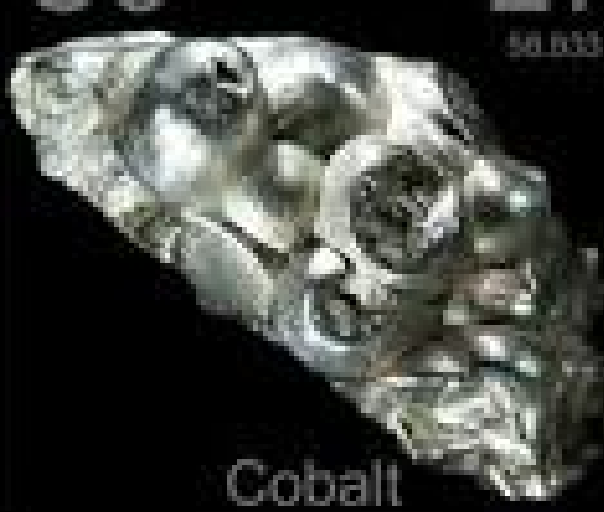

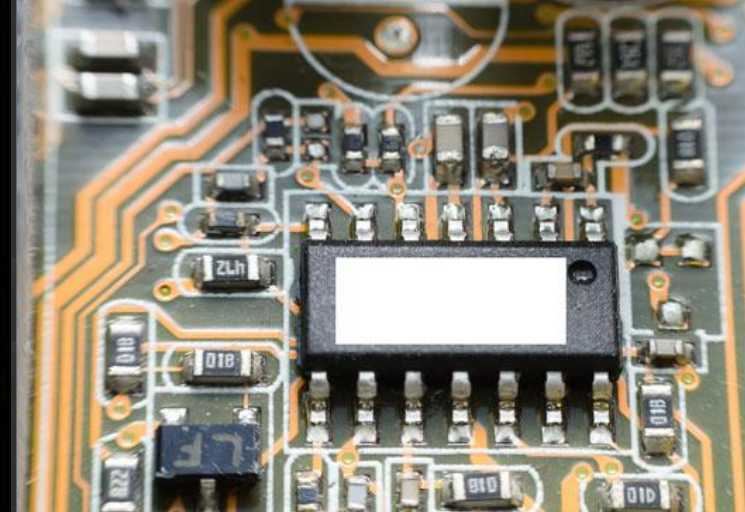
