- **9 p.m. February 1st, 2018** – Turn in your completed project to Brigade.
 - **Late submissions will not be accepted.**
- **February or March (date to be determined)** – Panel judging
- **April 8, 2018** -- The winners will be announced at the Brigade Awards Banquet.

Please note that the winning project will have shared ownership between the Brigader and the Brigade Organization for one year. This project may be utilized throughout the year to support and promote Brigade. All projects will be on display at the end of the year Awards Banquet.
