Services rendered by Calder Classics in exchange for Tuition Fee include and are limited to accommodations, breakfast plus either lunch or dinner, local transportation to sites, museum entries, instruction and course materials (certain additional books are purchased at student's expense), and transportation from and to the arrival/departure airport for those students who choose to travel with Calder Classics chaperones; transportation from and to the arrival/departure airport for students travelling independently will be at the student's expense. International travel is at the student's expense.

Cancellation Policy: Once a student has confirmed participation in a Calder Classics program by submitting the full tuition payment, no refunds will be available on or after the withdrawal deadline of May 1 (February 15 for Spring Break). Students submitting written notification of withdrawal to Calder Classics on or after April 1 (Feb 1) but before May 1 (Feb 15) will receive a tuition refund of 50%. Withdrawals prior to April 1 (Feb 1) will receive a tuition refund of 90%. Tuition for programs cancelled by Calder Classics will be refunded 100%. Participants are encouraged to obtain trip insurance for all travel costs associated with the program. Calder Classics is not responsible for any costs associated with student travel for any program.



## Consent and Release of Liability Waiver:

This is a legally binding Consent and Release of Liability Waiver made voluntarily by me, the Releaser, on my own behalf, and on the behalf of my heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives and assigns.

By signing this Waiver, and to the extent permitted by law, I waive any and all claims for damages for death, personal injury, loss or property damage which may have or which may hereafter accrue to me or my child against Calder Classics, its officers, directors, employees, agents, independent contractors and other representatives (hereinafter referred to jointly and severally as "Calder Classics") as a result of my child's participation in the Calder Classics program, and as related to the nature, type or condition of the events involved, and/or with respect to the condition of the sites involved, and/or with respect to the supervision provided, and/or with respect to the activities performed, whether or not caused by the negligence (active or passive) of Calder Classics.

This Waiver is signed in order for the Student to participate in this activity for his or her own personal enjoyment and benefit and is done so freely with full knowledge of the risk and dangers incident thereto. It is acknowledged that the Student will be traveling outside the USA to study with the inherent dangers and risks associated with activities associated with studying abroad, which include, but are not limited to: walking, hiking, swimming, use of all forms of public and private transportation, visits to public places, disease, food-borne illnesses, etc. It is also acknowledged that the student will be unsupervised during breaks and free days.

By signing this agreement, I further acknowledge that I agree to assume and bear sole responsibility for these dangers and risks and to absolve and hold harmless Calder Classics from any and all risks of any nature and kind associated with study abroad. I also agree to indemnify, defend, and hold Calder Classics free and harmless from any and all expenses, demands, claims, costs, losses, damages, recoveries, settlements, and expenses (including but not limited to interest, penalties, attorney's fees, expert witness fees, costs, and other expenses) of any nature or kind which are incurred by the indemnity ("losses"), known or unknown, contingent or otherwise, directly or indirectly arising from or related to the Student's participation in Calder Classics activities. No refund or adjustment is made, and no prior notice is made, if Calder Classics changes its program by adding, altering, or deleting activities as deemed necessary by the chaperones and/or teachers. It is also understood and agreed that Calder Classics has made no promise or pledge, express or implied, to provide any special facilities or services to those with any medical problems, health problems, or physical disabilities, including but not limited to accommodation of special diets.

Further, I understand and agree that, for the safety and comfort of everyone, Calder Classics is a non-smoking environment, and is in conformance with all applicable laws governing drug use, alcohol use by minors, environmental protection, health, and safety. Rules established to protect the property, privacy and safety of the Students will be enforced. Any student's willful violation of Calder Classics rules can lead to dismissal from the Calder Classics program. Calder Classics reserves the right to dismiss or remove Students for misbehavior at any time.



#### **Student Code of Conduct:**

Disciplinary action may be imposed whenever a student commits or attempts to commit any act of misconduct during the Calder Classics program, including but not limited to:

- 1. Possession, use or distribution of an illegal or controlled substance or look-alike drug.
- 2. Unauthorized and/or illegal possession, use or distribution of any alcoholic beverage.
- 3. Theft of property or service.
- 4. Intentional or willful and wanton destruction of property.
- 5. Assault and/or battery.
- 6. Possession of a weapon.
- 7. Conduct which constitutes harassment or abuse that threatens the mental well-being or safety of any individual.
- 8. Departure from the residence/group without permission.

Any student who breaks the rules specified under this Student Code of Conduct may be expelled immediately from the Calder Classics program (without refund) and asked to return home. Destination countries have very strict drug laws and Calder Classics will not be held responsible in the event any student breaks these laws.

There are Free Days scheduled in certain Sessions during which students have permission to be unsupervised; during this unsupervised time students may depart from the residence provided they are accompanied by at least one other student. There are also breaks during the day in all Calder Classics programs when students will be unsupervised. Students are expected to continue to adhere strictly to the Code of Conduct during these unsupervised times.

Students may not depart from the group except during scheduled Free Days/Breaks or unless specific arrangements have been made with the chaperones. If a student breaks this rule, he/she will be expelled from the Calder Classics program and will be asked to return home.

I acknowledge that if the Student is dismissed or otherwise removed from the Calder Classics program I will be completely responsible for the Student's transportation home, and that Calder Classics shall make no refunds of any funds paid in association with this program.
