GTC and Regis University recently celebrated the topping out of Clarke Hall on February 29, 2012. Attendance at the completion of the structure's top story included several Regis University staff and administration members, as well as project team members from Soderstrom Architects and Golden Triangle Construction. The final beam, sporting American and Regis University flags at either end, was signed by those present before it was hoisted to the top of the building.

There was a catered breakfast for those in attendance and a short commemoration speech by Father Mike Sheeran of Regis University, who blessed the project and poured holy water on the ground and the beam.

In charge of construction the ground-up facility, GTC's Senior Project Manager Kirk Johnston said, "This was an exciting event for both Regis University and GTC marking a milestone in the construction schedule and showing the great team effort between Regis University, Soderstrom Architects and GTC. We look forward to the successful completion of a landmark building at Regis University."

Clarke Hall is a 62,000 square foot general academic office building on the Regis University campus that will have a mix of open and closed office spaces, large meeting rooms and smaller break out rooms. This new facility will incorporate sustainability features and "green" building designs. It is scheduled to be complete in November 2012.
