



**Andrew McCarthy** is a director, an award winning travel writer, and—of course—an actor. He made his professional début at 19 while attending New York University as a theatre major in CLASS, with Rob Lowe and Jaqueline Bisset. He has since appeared in dozens of films, including THE SPIDERWICK CHRONICLES and THE JOY LUCK CLUB, as well as such iconic movies as PRETTY IN PINK, ST. ELMO'S FIRE, LESS THEN ZERO, and cult fa-

vorites WEEKEND AT BERNIE'S and MANNEQUIN. He has starred in over two dozen movies, acted in numerous TV shows, and appeared on Broadway as well. McCarthy was known as a member of the 1980s "Brat Pack" of young actors that included Anthony Michael Hall, Rob Lowe, Demi Moore, Molly Ringwald and Ally Sheedy.

He has starred on Broadway and on television, appearing on numerous shows including LIPSTICK JUNGLE, Stephen King's KINGDOM HOSPITAL, and all the LAW & ORDERs. He is also a highly regarded television director, having worked on ORANGE IS THE NEW BLACK, ALPHA HOUSE, BLACK BOX, GOSSIP GIRL and WHITE COLLAR, among others.

Simultaneously, Andrew is an award winning travel writer. He is an editor-at-large at National Geographic Traveler, and has written for The New York Times, The Wall Street Journal, The Los Angeles Times, The Atlantic, Travel+Leisure, AFAR, Men's Journal, Bon Appetit, and many others. He has received six Lowell Thomas awards, and been named Travel Journalist of the Year by The Society of American Travel Writers. His travel memoir, THE LONGEST WAY HOME, became a New York Times Best Seller, and the Financial Times of London named it one of the Best Books of 2012. In the fall of 2014 his work will appear in the Best American Travel series. He lives in New York.

#### **James Ponsoldt**

was born and raised in Athens, GA, received his bachelor's degree from Yale, and an MFA in directing from Columbia University. His first feature, OFF THE BLACK, premiered at the Sundance Film Festival in 2006. His second film, SMASHED, won a Special Jury Prize at Sundance in 2012.



received an Independent Spirit Award nomination for lead Mary Elizabeth Winstead and went on to critical acclaim worldwide. THE SPECTACULAR NOW received a Special Jury Prize at the the 2013 Sundance Film Festival, was nominated for multiple Independent Spirit Awards, and was released in theaters via A24 Films. THE END OF THE TOUR premiered at Sundance 2015, was released by A24 Films, and was nominated for two Independent Spirit Awards. Ponsoldt also directed the pilot of the Netflix series MASTER OF NONE and recently wrapped his newest feature, THE CIRCLE, starring Emma Watson, John Boyega and Tom Hanks.

**Charlie Hewson** is an actor and musician living in Los Angeles. G.T. in MY BLIND BROTHER is his favorite role to date. Other roles include the arch-villain Phears in MOSTLY GHOSTLY: HAVE YOU MET MY GHOULFRIEND?, Dr. Hazlit in WGN's UNDERGROUND (shot in Baton Rouge), and a recurring role as Agent Blake in USA's WHITE COLLAR. You may have also heard his voice in American Airlines and Applebee's commercials on the radio and TV.

In 1976 Burt Reynolds asked J.L. Parker to drive his motor home while he was filming *Gator* in Georgia. J.L. and his wife Cindy had no idea it would lead to a long career in the film industry. At Reynold's insistence, they moved to Los Angeles, and J.L. began working for Transportation Coordinator Paul Casella. During that time, he worked on the productions of *Annie Hall, Turning Point, Taxi, The Deer Hunter*, and Woody Allen's *Interiors*. There were many others, but J.L.'s favorite was *The Gathering of Old Men*. J.L. and Cindy moved back to Georgia in 1979, and J.L. worked in the electrical department on the production of *Wise Blood* in Macon. (A bit of trivia: J.L. was cast in the film as well, playing the role of Karl).

For nearly 40 years the Parkers were the leading Film Transportation Company for Georgia and the South – working together on many, many films including Driving Miss Daisy, Remember The Titans, Sweet Home Alabama, We Are Marshall, Diary of a Mad Black Woman (and other Tyler Perry films), Boxing Helena, and The War. They worked for TV movies such as Andersonville, Warm Springs, Sudie and Simpson, and Teen Wolf. They were sometimes called "The Macon Mafia" because of the wealth of contacts, family, and assets at their disposal. They continued to be favorites of Burt Reynolds (and remain close to this day) and Reynold's stunt director Hal Needham.

In 2011, J.L. and Cindy made the difficult decision to retire. The invitation to their retirement party read "That's a Wrap for J.L. and Cindy." In 2015 Macon Film Festival hosted Burt Reynolds as our Special Guest. He introduced us to the Parkers, and our friendship with them began.

Melvyn Douglas was born in Macon on April 5, 1901. His career began on Broadway in 1928 and alternated between stage and screen for the rest of his life. He

#### The Melvyn Douglas Best in Show Award

won Academy Awards for Best Supporting Actor in *Hud* and *Being There* (for which he also won a Golden Globe) and he was nominated for Best Actor for his work in *I Never Sang for My Father*.

He had memorable roles in *The Changeling, The Seduction of Joe Tynan, Death Takes a Holiday, Ninotchka* (opposite Greta Garbo) and *Ghost Story*. He won an Emmy Award for a CBS Playhouse performance and was nominated for his turn in *Inherit the Wind*, and he won a Tony Award for Best Actor in a Play for *The Best Man*.

His wife of 50 years, Helen Gahagan Douglas, was a three-term Congresswoman in California and served as Secretary of the Treasury under President Kennedy.

The Macon Film Festival "Best in Show" award was named in honor of Melvyn Douglas during the 5th Annual Macon Film Festival in 2010. Douglas' granddaughter, actress Illeana Douglas, accepted the honor on behalf of the Douglas family.

# The Karen Black Audience Choice Award for Narrative Feature

Karen Black performed in over 150 films as well as many Broadway and off-Broadway plays. Her performance opposite Jack Nicholson in *Five Easy* 

Pieces made her a star and household name, and earned her an Oscar nomination and a Golden Globe for Best Supporting Actress. She won another Golden Globe for her role in *The Great Gatsby* with Robert Redford and was nominated for a Golden Globe as Best Actress for John Schlesinger's Day of the Locust. Ms. Black appeared in numerous other iconic films such as Easy Rider, Airport 1975, Come Back to the Five and Dime Jimmy, Jimmy Dean, Nashville (which garnered a Grammy nomination) and Alfred Hitchcock's Family Plot. She reached a new generation of fans more recently with her role as Mother Firefly in Rob Zombie's House of a 1,000 Corpses.


Ms. Black was a great supporter of independent film and a featured guest of the 2008 Macon Film Festival, screening Steve Balderson's *Firecracker*. During her visit, Ms. Black captivated the hearts of Central Georgia and Macon Film Festival patrons and guests. She returned to Macon in 2009 to film *Stuck*, and again in 2010 when the film screened at the 5th Annual Macon Film Festival. She spent several weeks in Macon in September 2009 rehearsing and performing in her play *Missouri Waltz*.

Ms. Black touched our hearts with her wit, charm and endearing personality. It is our great honor and pleasure to name the Macon Film Festival Audience Choice Award for Narrative Feature after our dear friend Karen Black.
