

Tea Frenzy – The Flying Teapot Word Game

Description

Tea Frenzy is a light-hearted word creation game for iOS and Android. Players zoom a flying teapot through the air to intercept letters and spell words on a silver tray. Flying sugar cubes give bonus points.

Gameplay comes in two-minute rounds and combines arcade and strategy elements. Letters are worth points based on their frequency in English words, and multipliers are given for longer words.

Origin of the game

The game started with a joke uttered at a party: “Flappy words,” which led to the idea of creating a physics-based word game. Why not combine the then-popular tap/flying mechanic with letter capture to spell words?

The teapot and teabag theme came much later, inspired by the author’s penchant for that delicious, invigorating beverage.

About the developer

Brooks Peck is a museum curator who specializes in popular culture and science fiction. For EMP Museum in Seattle he has created exhibitions about *Battlestar Galactica*, *Avatar*, space-themed album art, and others. He is the co-writer of two Syfy Channel original films: *Rage of the Yeti* and *Zombie Apocalypse*. His favorite variety of tea is Keemun.
