Our Staff

Tall Pines School summer camp staff members are chosen for their experience, ability to relate to children, and leadership skills. Our teaching staff is composed of trained teachers. Our counsellors are primarily university students. Our staff undergoes an extensive training program that begins with our pre-camp meetings, and continues throughout the summer.

Our Facilities

Our facilities are clean and fully air-conditioned. Campers are provided with a safe and comfortable environment. Our indoor facilities include a full size gymnasium, art studio, science lab, computer lab, library and multiple classrooms. Our outdoor facilities include four playgrounds, a full size basketball court and a soccer field.

Lunch

Campers will have lunch from 12:00 p.m. to 1:00 p.m. daily. All campers are required to bring their own lunch to camp. Please ensure all lunches are nut-free. Every Friday, campers will have the opportunity to purchase pizza for lunch. Order forms will be sent out on the Monday of each weekly session.

Allergen Reduced Environment

Please avoid packing foods that contain common allergens such as peanuts or nuts of any kind.

Program Cancellations

Tall Pines School reserves the right to limit enrollment and change instructors when appropriate. We also reserve the right to combine or cancel activities due to insufficient enrollment. We are unable to guarantee additional sessions if enrollment exceeds expectations, so please enroll early. Further we reserve the right to cancel an activity by 3:30 p.m. one week before the camp session is scheduled to begin. In such cases, all fees for the cancelled session will be refunded.

Refund Policy

All requests for refunds must be made in writing. Refunds, less a \$50 administrative charge, will be issued for all camp cancellations up to four weeks prior to the first day of camp. Pro-rated rates and refunds for missed days are not available.
