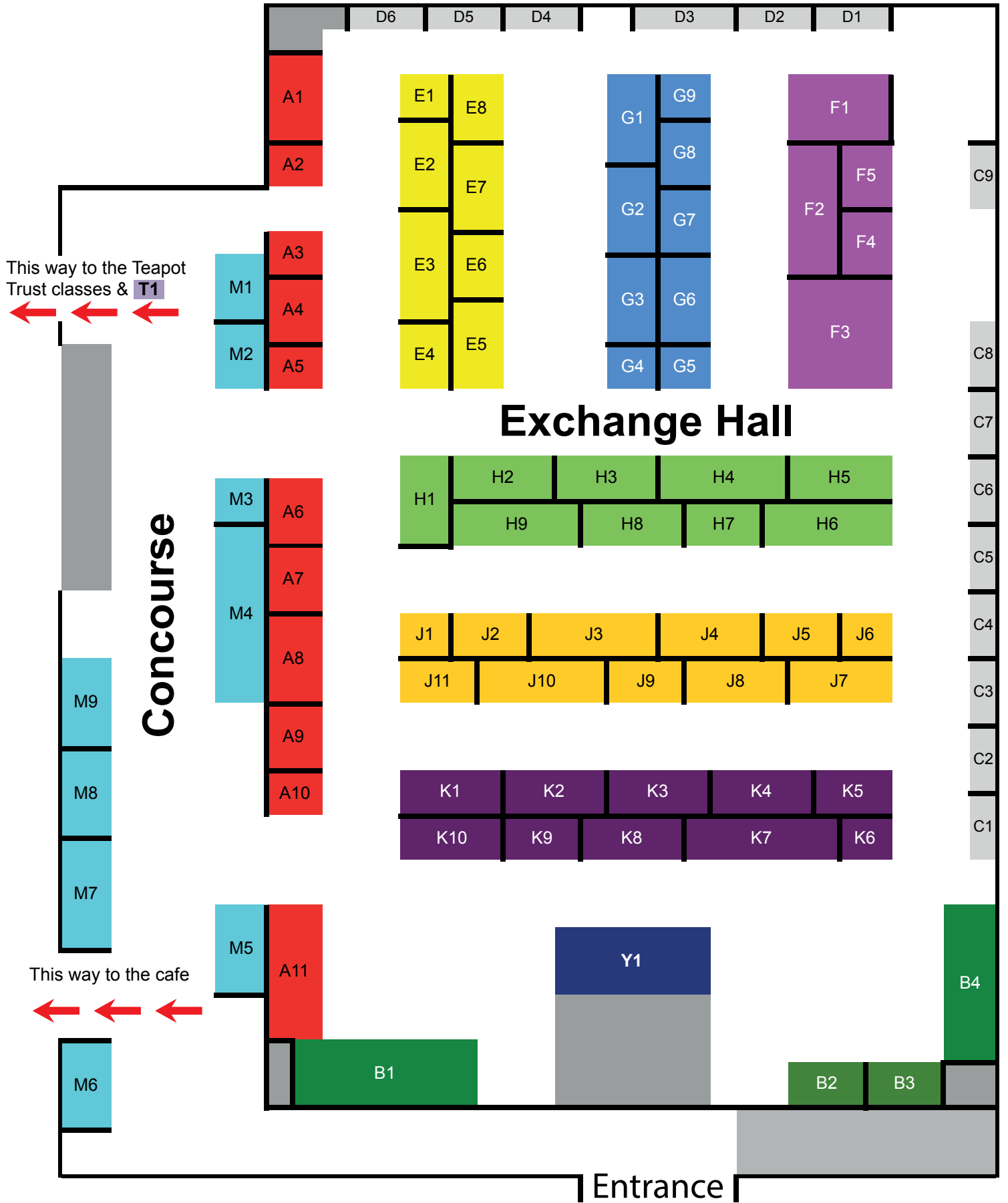

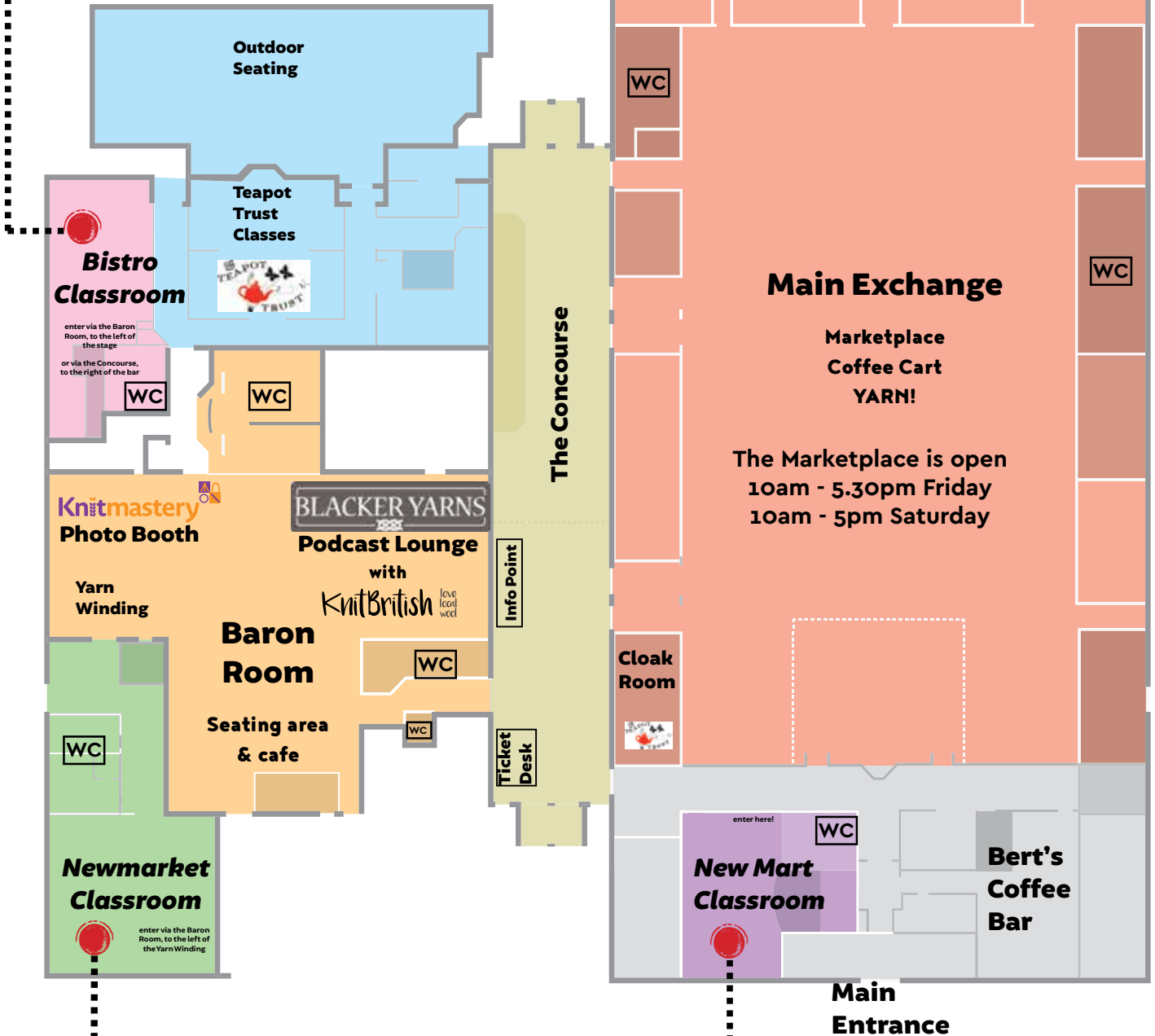

Lothian Bus 35

Approx. every 12 minutes from across the road, via Fountainbridge, Lauriston Place, National Museum of Scotland, Royal Mile, onwards towards Leith

Lothian Bus 4/44

Approx every 6-10 minutes from opposite Slateford Station, via Haymarket, Princes St, London Road, onwards to east Edinburgh

Lothian Bus 34

Approx every 12 mins from opposite Slateford Station via Fountainbridge, Lothian Road, Princes St, onwards to Leith

GETTING TO EYF

BY TRAIN

The nearest main line station is Edinburgh Haymarket. The same buses go from outside both Edinburgh Waverley (Princes St) and Haymarket Stations. (see BY BUS)

For those coming from Glasgow, the train from Glasgow Central stops at Slateford Station, which is a 2 minute walk from the venue. Please check [ScotRail](#) for details. (Note that Slateford Station is unstaffed and access is via stairs. It's not fantastic for buggies and definitely not accessible to wheelchair users.)

BY BUS

[Lothian Buses](#) is Edinburgh's main bus operator and the number 35 stops right on the doorstep of the Corn Exchange. It runs through the city from the north east, up the Royal Mile, and out to the airport. From Princes St or Haymarket, take the 4, 34, 44 or 44A to Slateford Station, a few minutes' walk from the venue. There is some information on the preceding page, but check the Lothian Buses website for full timetables.

The fare for an adult for any journey (not incl. Airlink bus 100) is £1.60 - exact change only. A day ticket is £4.00 and is good value if you need to do more than two journeys.

BY AIR

[Edinburgh International Airport Destinations/Airlines](#) - great transport links and the journey time to the city centre is approx. 30 mins by tram or Airlink Bus (number 100). The number 35 Lothian Bus actually connects the airport and the venue direct, so it's feasible to fly in for the day :)

BY COACH

You can also travel by coach to Edinburgh City Centre and choose one of the local transport options to get to the venue. The Bus Station is located at St Andrews Square in the heart of the city, allowing quick access to local buses and trains.

BY CAR

The postcode for the Corn Exchange is EH14 1RJ. The venue has around 400 parking spaces, but please note we can't guarantee that the car park will have room for all, as it is well used by the other amenities which form part of the complex! Plenty of free on-street parking is available within walking distance. There is a limited number of disabled parking places at the back of the venue. It has not been possible to arrange for these to be closer to the main entrance.

BY TAXI

City Cabs and Central Taxis are both quite reliable and have apps which can be used for booking - otherwise give them a ring. Numbers on preceding page.

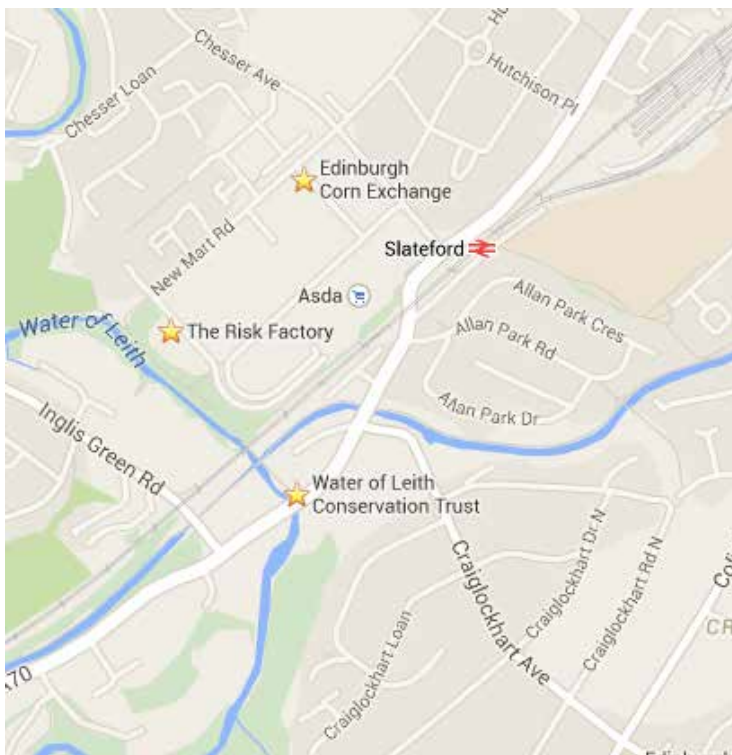

OUR TEACHING VENUES



[Edinburgh Corn Exchange, 11 New Market Road, Edinburgh, EH14 1RJ](#)

This is our principal venue: marketplace in the Main Exchange and the Concourse, some classes, food and drink, loads of seating so you can socialise, the Blacker Podcast Lounge in the Baron Room, the Knitmastery Photo Booth, and more...There's a map of the whole venue on a previous page. There's the Newmarket Room, The New Mart Room (too similar but we can't change the names!) and the Bistro Cottage Room. All details of the classrooms at the Corn Exchange will be available at the venue.

[The Risk Factory, 20 New Mart Rd, EH14 1RL](#)

Leaving the Corn Exchange, turn left and left again so you are walking around the side of the building. Follow the road as it curves to the left and you'll see a large, modern, green building. About 5 mins walk from the Corn Exchange on paved roads. There is some parking here but as ever, we can't guarantee a space.

[The Water of Leith Conservation Trust, 24 Lanark Road, EH14 1TQ](#)

You can approach this building two ways. Lanark Road is a main road served by buses 34 and 44. Or, it's a pleasant 10-15 min walk from the Corn Exchange. Leaving the Corn Exchange, turn left and left again so you are walking around the side of the building. Follow the road and cross it before it curves around to the left. There is a footpath with some apartments to the right. Follow the footpath and then turn left to follow the Water of Leith (it's unpaved from here but in good condition). Don't turn off the riverside path. Go under the viaduct and you'll soon see the Water of Leith Centre. There is a tiny car park at this venue but having tried it, be assured it is very tight even in a small car!
