Camp medical people cannot administer any medicines that are not properly labeled, in their original containers, and recorded on the camper's health form.** They also cannot provide Tylenol, aspirin, or any over-the-counter medicine unless it is sent with the camper and indicated on the health form. We want to do our best to not inadvertently cause harm to campers by improperly dispensing medicine. Please make sure to fully complete your camper's Health Form!
- Campers should be able to fully enjoy the camping experience and not be distracted from hearing God's voice at camp. Please do not bring cell phones, iPods, video games, or other electronic equipment.
